## The NRA's PPC State Team Postal Match was conceived and instituted in 1992.

A state's Postal Team is comprised of the top six competitor scores as shot at their State Championship. Each competitor must reside in the state whose team he/she is a member of. At the end of the year, the highest scoring State Postal Team is announced from those teams submitting Postal Team Scores.

Each State Postal Team member receives a brassard and hat pin, with the high scoring state team members receiving the NRA Police Pistol Combat State Team Medal.

Teams: One team from each state may fire in the NRA Police Pistol Combat Team Postal Match. Teams will consist of six firing members and all must be residents of the state they represent.

Team Selection: The top <u>six</u> state resident shooters of the aggregate of PPC Matches 1 thru 5 for Revolver or Matches 8 thru 12 for Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol.

When Firing: State Outdoor Police Pistol Combat Championship Tournaments must be fired before December 31 in order to enter a team in the State Team Postal Match. This firing report, properly completed, must be received at NRA Headquarters by January 10<sup>th</sup> to be considered.
