
Firearms / Rounds Required: Duty Handgun = 20 Rounds

Start Position: Posted with Ballistic Shield, heels on Start Line with Loaded Duty Handgun at Ready Position.

Course Description: Local task force members have completed a long term investigation into an area Posse Comitatus group and a Grand Jury has issued multiple arrest and search warrants for tax evasion, fraud, failing to register vehicles, manufacturing fraudulent driver's licenses, and Failure to Appear. Patrol personnel have been asked to assist with entry and securing the scene of the several locations. You and your partner have been detailed to secure a small multiple room commercial office / storage building they are leasing. After knocking and announcing your authority and intentions you open the door and begin entry using your ballistic shield. As soon as you enter you see a subject point a handgun at you.

On the Start Signal, enter the Firing Area and clear the structure engaging Threat Targets 1-10 as seen.

- ◆ The Ballistic Shield must be carried so as to protect your upper body and you must look through the Viewport <u>at all times</u> except when Reloading or taking Immediate Action. One warning will be issued for failing to use the Viewport. Afterwards one Procedural will be assessed for each Threat Target engaged if the handgun is not sighted through the Viewport.
- Reloading: For Safety Consistency the handgun will be placed in the holster and magazines exchanged as needed. Slide Release may only be done using the Slide Release, or hooking the rear sight on the side of the Ballistic Shield with the muzzle downrange.
- Immediate Action: TAP the Magazine on the side of the Ballistic Shield, RACK the slide by hooking the rear sight on the side of the Ballistic Shield with the muzzle down range, and engage threats if still necessary.
- Feedway Clearance: For Safety Consistency, lower the Ballistic Shield directly in front of you to provide cover to your lower torso and legs and use both hands to LOCK the slide open, RIP out the magazine, RACK the slide several times, TAP in a new magazine, RACK the slide and be READY to engage threats if still necessary.
