

Start Position: Standing with heels touching marks. Patrol Rifle in Cruiser Safe Condition at Safety Circle Position.

Course Description: You are working daylight patrol and have been dispatched to assist in the search for an armed robbery suspect who escaped after a foot pursuit. You just left your cruiser and are moving to check a row of townhouse backyards.

On the Start Signal, search the area and from within the Firing Area engage any Threat Targets found.

NOTE: You must be able to see that the target is a Threat prior to firing. You cannot blindly shoot thru a sheet because you see the base of a target stand.

Course Material & Supplies

- □ Threat Overlays for Targets = 14 plus a supply of replacements
- □ Target Stands = 15

- □ Fence Sections 6' x 8' = 6 2 with Slot Ports as illustrated
- □ Visual Wall Barriers Approx. 7 feet x 6 feet = 4
- □ Bed Sheets = 4 Cord to hold sheet corners down if windy

Stake Ratchet End

□ Wood 2" x 4" x 6" to make clothesline supports = 4

□ Bolts with nuts – 4" x 1/4 inch for above

□ Rope to make clotheslines – Approximately 100 feet

□ Ratchet Tie Down Strap = 2


□ Conduit Wall Supports = 20 +/-

□ Rebar Stakes = 4

Ratchet Strap Tie Down: Adjust strap to reach top of upright.

Make rope as taught as possible after running it thru the uprights and tie a loop in the end of the rope. Connect the ratchet strap to the loop and tighten ratchet strap to tension the rope.

The tension on the rope will pull down on the uprights and keep them in position.



Drill 1/2" hole in top of each upright

and run rope through holes
