The Magnolia Classic will offer NRA's Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol Match, Open Class Revolver Match, Distinguished Semi-Automatic Pistol Match, Distinguished Revolver Match, Production Distinguished Match and Two and Four Officer Open Class Team Matches.

Governing Rules: Current NRA Police Pistol Combat Rules will govern throughout the Tournament. All competitors are encouraged to review the current PPC rules. The NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book is available on-line at ppc.nra.org.

Individual Eligibility: Open to any eligible law enforcement member as outlined in Police Pistol Combat Rule Section 2.4. Competitors must show credentials showing eligibility at check in.

Team Eligibility: Teams will consist of two or four firing members and a Team Captain. The Team Captain may be a competing member of the team. Police Pistol Combat Rule 2.8 requires that all team members must be from the same agency. Membership can include officers retired from the agency if they are not now employed by another eligible agency. Eligible Military competitors who are also regular full time law enforcement, industrial law enforcement, or reserve/auxiliary law enforcement must sign up with other members from their law enforcement agency.

A competitor may not fire as a member of both a two and four officer team in that tournament. However, an officer may fire on a two-officer team with a Revolver and a four-officer team with a Semi-Automatic Pistol and vice versa or when the firearm required is different than the first team match.

No "pick-up" teams are allowed.

Registration: Pre-Registration is highly recommend and will allow us to have your competitor packet ready for you at check in. The Pre-Registration deadline is May 8th. All competitors need to complete the Competitor Registration Form on the last page. Team Registrations will only be accepted the day of the day of the match.

Classification: Competitors will be entered using their current NRA Police Pistol Combat Classification of High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, Marksman, or Classified. Competitors with expired Classifications and new shooters with no Classification or those without a Temporary Record Score Book will fire in the High Master Class as required by PPC Rule 19.2. Competitors will be divided by Class provided there are five or more in each Class. If there are less than five entries in any Class they may be combined with the next higher class. Teams will not be divided by class. Competitors may check their current NRA Classification at LEcompetitions.nra.org.

Categories: Category assignments will not be used.

Squadding: All matches will be squadded. Squadding information may be picked up at the times indicated on the daily schedule.

Tournament Fees: Entry fees will be paid on the day of the Tournament. Where applicable, fees include NRA Match Fees.

Targets: Official NRA B-27 targets will be used.

Scoring: Competitor scoring will be used. Pursuant to PPC Rule 14.2, **NO** competitor will score their own target NOR may a competitor score the targets of a competitor from their same agency. If this cannot be avoided due to the Relay's makeup contact a Tournament Official to score the targets.

PPC Rules prohibit the use of plug-type scoring gauges but Overlays and Eagle Eyes may be used by competitors. It is the competitor's responsibility to make sure that their score card is complete with signatures, and is turned in to the stat office as soon as possible. Check your hits, scores, and totals before signing your score card. Once the score card is signed, the value of the shots recorded on that card is FINAL and cannot be changed.

Preliminary Match Bulletins: Match scores will be posted with a protest time listed. It is the responsibility of the competitor to check their scores for accuracy before the protest time has expired.

Tournament Result Bulletin: Final Results will be posted immediately after the last match scores are finalized and registered competitors will be provided a copy after the Tournament.

Awards Schedule: All awards will be given at the conclusion of the last match.

The rest of the Open Class Division Awards are assigned to those competitors who fire both the Open Class Revolver Matches and Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol Matches. Shooter's scores will be added together to create the Open Class 3000 Aggregate Match with Classifications being determined by averaging as outlined in PPC Rule 19.16.

There must be 9 shooters in a Class to go down to third Place, 6 shooters for Second Place and or 3 for First Place. If there are fewer than 3 shooters in a Class, they will be combined with the next highest class.

Safety Equipment: It is required that all competitors wear ear and eye protection while on the range.

Alcohol: The Possession or consumption of Alcoholic Beverages at or around the Range is absolutely prohibited

Optical Devices: No optical devices, other than normal glasses worn for corrective eyesight purposes, safety glasses, or sun glasses are permitted on the range during firing for use by competitors or team officials. Optical devices have also been interpreted to prohibit the use of mechanical iris, and eye patch or eye cover. For team coaches during the Team Match, see PPC Rule 12.6.

Refires: No refires will be allowed for defective guns or ammunition or other malfunctions of the competitor's equipment. Competitors may clear jams or malfunctions provided that safe conditions are maintained.

Sighting Shots: No sighting shots will be allowed.

Courses of Fire: The Range Officer will announce the course of fire, shooting positions and time prior to the start of each Match and Stage. Time will start with a loaded gun in holster. No part of the competitor's hand may touch the gun or holster until the command to commence firing is given.

All loading will be with cartridges taken from the competitor's pocket, cartridge belt, mechanical loaders, or special pouch. To force reloading under time restraints, magazine loading is limited to 6 rounds per magazine. There is no limit on the number of magazines you have but all used during the firing of a stage or string **MUST** be on your person.

A conventional right or left-hand holster must be used. For safety reasons, shoulder, cross draw or holsters which require releasing by insertion of finger within the trigger guard will not be allowed. Holster cannot be tied down.

Match 3	Match 10	At 50 yards, 24 rounds fired; 6 shots sitting; 6 shots prone; 6 shots standing left handed with support from behind left side of barricade; 6 shots standing right handed with support from behind right side of barricade. All shots may be fired single or double action. Time limit 2 minutes and 45 seconds including time to reload.
Match 4	Match 11	At 25 yards, 24 rounds fired in two stages of 12 shots each fired double action, standing without support. Time limit 35 seconds for each 12-shot stage including time to reload.
Match 5	Match 12	Stage 1: 7 yards, 12 shots double action standing without support. Time limit 20 seconds including time to reload. Stage 2: 25 yards, 6 shots kneeling; 6 shots standing left handed with support from behind left side of barricade, and 6 shots standing right handed with support from behind right side of barricade. All fired double action. Time limit 90 seconds, including time to reload. <i>Change Targets</i> Stage 3: 50 yards, 6 shots sitting; 6 shots prone; 6 shots standing left handed with support from behind left side of barricade and 6 shots standing right

APPLIES TO ALL FIREARMS		Rule 3.1
Each competitor is responsible for their firearm and any which may be questionable should be submitted to the Tournament Director, Referee, or 3-Man Jury for decision prior to being used. All standard safety features of the pistol must operate properly. With respect to Sections 3.2 through 3.10, and in addition to the firearm specific regulations below, the following features are either Allowed or Prohibited on all firearms.
