# Mississippi Police Combat State Championship Tournament



Sponsored by the **Mississippi Police Marksman Association** and Sanctioned by the **NRA Law Enforcement Division** Thursday May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018



The Mississippi Police Marksman Association is proud to host the Mississippi Police Combat State Championship Tournament at the Mississippi Law Enforcement Officers Training Academy.

The Championship will offer the NRA Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol Match, Open Class Revolver Match, Stock Service Semi-Automatic Pistol Match and Stock Service Revolver Match.

We have scheduled the State Championship to precede the Mississippi Magnolia Classic Police Pistol Combat NRA Regional Tournament which will take place the next day, on Friday and Saturday, May 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>. This will let you participate in two PPC Regional Level Tournaments in just three days so you can have plenty of trigger time while reducing your travel time and cost.

**Governing Rules:** Current NRA Police Pistol Combat Rules will govern throughout the Tournament. All competitors are encouraged to review the current PPC rules. The NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book is available on-line at **ppc.nra.org**.

**Individual Eligibility:** Open to any eligible law enforcement member as outlined in Police Pistol Combat Rule Section 2.4. Competitors must show credentials showing eligibility at check in.

You do not have to be an NRA Member to compete in NRA Sanctioned Competitions but you do need to be a member of the Mississippi Police Marksman Association for this Championship. If not a current member you can join or renew during Registration.

**Registration:** Pre-Registration **is requested and highly recommended** and will allow us to have your competitor packet ready for you at check in. The **Pre-Registration deadline is May 7<sup>th</sup>**. All competitors need to complete the Competitor Registration Form on the last page.

The Statistical Office will open at 0700 for Check In, Registration payments, and on-site Registration. Make sure you bring Credentials showing eligibility, NRA Membership Card if applicable and your current PPC Classification Card if you have an assigned NRA Classification.

**Classification:** Competitors will be entered using their current NRA Police Pistol Combat Classification of High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, Marksman, or Classified. Competitors with expired Classifications and new shooters with no Classification or those without a Temporary Record Score Book will fire in the High Master Class as required by PPC Rule 19.2. Competitors may check their current NRA Classification at **LEcompetitions.nra.org**.

**Categories:** Category assignments will not be used.

**Tournament Fees:** Entry fees will be paid on the day of the Tournament. Where applicable, fees include NRA Match Fees.

**Targets:** Official NRA B-27 Cardboard Targets and Repair Centers will be used.

**Scoring:** Competitor scoring will be used. Pursuant to PPC Rule 14.2, **NO** competitor will score their own target NOR may a competitor score the targets of a competitor from their same agency. If this cannot be avoided due to the Relay's makeup contact a Match Official to score the targets. PPC Rules prohibit the use of plug-type scoring gauges. Overlays and Eagle Eyes may be used by competitors.

Score cards must be signed and are FINAL once signed so **PLEASE** double check the recorded hits and values BEFORE signing.

**Result Bulletins:** Final Results will be posted immediately after the last match scores are finalized. Competitors will be provided printed copies or results may be sent electronically.

#### Match & Relay Schedule:

- Statistical Office opens at 0700
- Open Class Revolver Matches 1 thru 5 First Relay begins at 0900
- Stock Service Revolver Match 7 Begins after the last Match 5 Relay
- Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol Matches 8 thru 12 Begins after the last Match 7 Relay
- Stock Service Semi-Automatic Pistol Match 14 Begins after the last Match 12 Relay

#### Remember to sign up for the Magnolia Classic PPC Regional Tournament being fired here Friday and Saturday with a Practice Day on Wednesday.

**Awards Schedule:** All awards will be given at the conclusion of the last match. The First Place competitors of each Class will be awarded their Tournament Fee back. If there are less than three competitors in a Class, the competitors in that Class will combined with the next higher Class.

### **Open Class Revolver Match 6 & Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol Match 13**

There must be 9 shooters in a Class to go down to third Place, 6 shooters for Second Place and or 3 for First Place. If there are fewer than 3 shooters in a Class, they will be combined with the next highest class.

**Courses of Fire:** The Range Officer will announce the course of fire, shooting positions and time prior to the start of each Match and Stage. Time will start with a loaded gun in holster. No part of the competitor's hand may touch the gun or holster until the command to commence firing is given.

All loading will be with cartridges taken from the competitor's pocket, cartridge belt, mechanical loaders, or special pouch. To force reloading under time restraints, magazine loading is limited to 6 rounds per magazine. There is no limit on the number of magazines you have but all used during the firing of a stage or string MUST be on your person.

A conventional right or left-hand holster must be used. For safety reasons, shoulder, cross draw or holsters which require releasing by insertion of finger within the trigger guard will not be allowed. Holster cannot be tied down.
