FIREARMS

ONLY Law Enforcement Duty Handgun, Duty Shotgun & Duty Rifles allowed. NO competition guns permitted except as allowed for Invitational Shoot-with-a-Cop Program shooters.

ROUND COUNT

Round Count & other info is sent by e-mail to registered shooters 5 to 7 days prior to event.

- ➔ *Want a chance to run through live fire scenario based training courses ?*
- ➔ *Was qualification the last time you used your duty firearms ?*
- ➔ *Want to see how your skills compare with other officers ?*
- ➔ *If the answer is Yes to any of these, you need to come out and shoot a NRA Tactical Police Competition training event.*

The NRA Law Enforcement Division Tactical Police Competition program is designed for public and private sworn law enforcement officers and U.S. Military members. Each TPC event incorporates 6 unique multi-gun training courses of fire to allow you to practice and evaluate your skills using your duty firearms and gear. This training places you in skill based and law enforcement live fire scenarios and requires you to solve the challenges presented according to your own tactics and training.

Just bring your duty guns, gear, ammunition, and a desire to learn and have fun.

REMEMBER ➔ Law Enforcement & Military shooters can sponsor a civilian to join them to shoot this event under the Shoot-with-a-Cop Program so they can experience what today's law enforcement officers face on the street. Family & spectators are welcome!

Awards: Division & LE Category Trophies with a Guns & Gear Prize Table for LE & MIL Shooters.

Cost: Register with Payment by February 25th = \$55 ❖ After February 25th = \$75

Two Member Team Challenge: \$20 Both shooters **MUST** be Law Enforcement or Military AND from the same agency for regular teams. Officers from different agencies or a mix of civilian and LE shooters can sign up as an Invitational Team. Please note that this is NOT a separate match, individual team member scores are added together to get the team score with trophies awarded to the top three teams.

Gear You Need: Eyes & Ears, Duty Handgun, Rifle & Shotgun gear. Equipment, firearm requirements, and rules are in the TPC Standards posted at lecompetitions.nra.org.

DIVISIONS

Patrol Division: Duty Handgun, Rifle, and Pump Shotgun, all with Iron Sights.

Tactical Division: Duty Rifle can have one optic, Iron Sight Pump or Semi-Automatic Duty Shotgun, and Duty Handgun with Iron Sights or **approved** Duty Handgun Optic.

Maximum Rifle Caliber is 6.8mm.
