## NRA Police Pistol Combat Tournament Announcement



The Memphis Police Pistol Team will sponsor a series of NRA Registered Police Pistol Combat Tournaments at the Memphis Police Firing Range. Tournaments will offer the NRA Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol Match, Open Class Revolver Match, and Production Semi-Auto Match. These Tournaments are a great way for you to evaluate your skill level, identify needed training areas, and practice your handgun skills to keep you prepared for the ever-increasing dangers you face on the street and off duty.

**NEW SHOOTERS** - you do NOT need any fancy gear or guns to start shooting these matches. Just bring your duty handgun, four magazines, holster & magazine pouch. There is nothing to memorize, the course will be announced as you shoot just like the stages during a qualification and fellow officers will gladly help you out. You can even use your stock duty gun to fire the Open Class Division matches to get started and see how challenging and fun these matches are.

**Dates:** Before planning to attend any Tournament Date shooters need to call ahead to ensure the Tournament Date has not been changed due to changes in the ranges availability, weather, staffing, etc.

**Governing Rules:** Current NRA Police Pistol Combat Rules will govern throughout the Tournament. All competitors are encouraged to review the current PPC rules. The NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book is available on-line at <https://lecompetitions.nra.org/police-pistol-combat/>. You can also use your smart phone camera to scan the Quick Reader Code to the right or double click it with your computer cursor.



**Eligibility:** Open to any eligible law enforcement member as outlined in Police Pistol Combat Rule Section 2.4.

**Registration:** Registration will be on site and start at 8:30 am with the first relay beginning at 9:00 am.

**Tournament Fees:** *Includes NRA Match Fees*

- Open Class Division Match-----\$ 20.00
- Production Pistol Match-----\$ 5.00

**Classification:** Competitors will be entered using their current NRA Police Pistol Combat Classification of High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, Marksman, or Classified. Competitors with expired Classifications and new shooters with no Classification or those without a Temporary Record Score Book will fire in the High Master Class as required by PPC Rule 19.2.

**Categories:** There will be no categories used in these Tournaments.

**Awards:**

- Open Class Division: Overall Winner receives a cash award. If there are three or more in a Class, Class Winners will receive a cash award.
- Production Pistol: Overall winner will receive a cash award.

**Targets:** Official NRA B-27 targets will be used.

**Competitors MUST bring their own staple guns and staples.**

**Scoring:** Competitor scoring will be used. Pursuant to PPC Rule 14.2, NO competitor will score their own target NOR may a competitor score the targets of a competitor from their same agency. If this cannot be avoided due to the Relay's makeup contact a Match Official to score the targets. PPC Rules prohibit the use of plug-type scoring gauges. Overlays and Eagle Eyes may be used by competitors.

Score cards must be signed and are FINAL once signed so **PLEASE** double check the recorded hits and values BEFORE signing.

**Firearms & Ammunition Allowed:** Please see NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book Sections 3.1, 3.2, 3.3, 3.6 and 3.7. Call if you have any questions.

**Courses of Fire:** To force reloading under time restraints and magazines are loaded with a maximum of 6 rounds. All times start with loaded gun in holster with hands at sides.

<b>Open Class Division Matches – "The 1500's"</b>		<i>150 Rounds Total</i>
Match 1	Match 8	Two stages of 12 shots each fired double action standing without support. First stage fired at 7 yards and second stage fired at 15 yards. Time limit is 20 seconds per stage including time to reload.
Match 2	Match 9	At 25 yards, 18 rounds fired; 6 shots kneeling; 6 shots standing left handed with support from behind left side of barricade, 6 shots standing right handed with support from behind right side of barricade, all fired double action. Time limit 90 seconds, including time to reload.
Match 3	Match 10	At 50 yards, 24 rounds fired; 6 shots sitting; 6 shots prone; 6 shots standing left handed with support from behind left side of barricade; 6 shots standing right handed with support from behind right side of barricade. All shots may be fired single or double action. Time limit 2 minutes and 45 seconds including time to reload.
Match 4	Match 11	At 25 yards, 24 rounds fired in two stages of 12 shots each fired double action, standing without support. Time limit 35 seconds for each 12-shot stage including time to reload.
Match 5	Match 12	Stage 1: 7 yards, 12 shots double action standing without support. Time limit 20 seconds including time to reload. Stage 2: 25 yards, 6 shots kneeling; 6 shots standing left handed with support from behind left side of barricade, and 6 shots standing right handed with support from behind right side of barricade. All fired double action. Time limit 90 seconds, including time to reload. <i>Change Targets</i> Stage 3: 50 yards, 6 shots sitting; 6 shots prone; 6 shots standing left handed with support from behind left side of barricade and 6 shots standing right handed with support from behind right side of barricade. All shots may be fired single or double action. Time limit 2 minutes and 45 seconds including time to reload. Stage 4: 25 yards, 6 shots double action standing without support. Time limit 12 seconds.
Match 6	Match 13	Match 6 is the Aggregate of the shooter's Open Class Revolver Match 1 through Match 5 scores with a total possible score of 1500 points. Match 13 is the Aggregate of the shooter's Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol Match 8 through 12 scores with a total possible score of 1500 points.
<b>NRA Production Pistol Match</b>		<i>48 Rounds Total</i>
Match 23 <i>Production Pistols</i>	NRA Stock Service Duty Gun Match Stage 1: 3 yards, 6 shots one handed standing without support in 8 seconds. Stage 2: 7 yards, 12 shots, one or two handed standing without support position. Twenty second time limit which includes required reload. <i>Change Targets</i> Stage 3: 15 yards, 12 shots, one or two handed standing without support. Twenty second time limit which includes required reload. Stage 4: 25 yards, 18 shots, one or two handed; 6 shots kneeling, from behind the right side of the barricade for cover and support; 6 shots standing left handed from behind the left side of the barricade; and 6 shots standing right handed from behind the right side of the barricade. Time limit is ninety seconds which includes the required two reloads.
