

# Announcing the South Carolina Police Combat League Monthly NRA Police Pistol Combat Tournaments



The South Carolina Police Combat League is sponsoring a series of NRA Sanctioned Police Pistol Combat Tournaments in 2019.

Each Tournament will be offering a variety of different sanctioned NRA Matches such as the NRA Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol Match, Open Class Revolver Match, Production Semi-Automatic Pistol Match, Stock Service Semi-Automatic Pistol Match, Stock Service Revolver Match and the Off Duty Match. Some Tournaments will also offer a hybrid version of the NRA Police Shotgun Match.

#### **First Time Shooters**

These Tournaments are a great way for you to evaluate your skill level, identify needed training areas, and practice your handgun skills to keep you prepared for the ever-increasing dangers you face on the street and off duty. You do NOT need any fancy gear or guns to start shooting these matches. Just bring your duty handgun, four magazines, holster & magazine pouch. There is nothing to memorize, the course will be announced as you shoot just like the stages during a qualification and fellow officers will gladly help you out. You can even use your stock duty gun to fire the Open Class Division matches to get started and see how challenging and fun these matches are.

**Governing Rules:** Current NRA Police Pistol Combat Rules will govern throughout the Tournament. All competitors are encouraged to review the current PPC rules. The NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book is available on-line at <a href="https://lecompetitions.nra.org/police-pistol-combat/">https://lecompetitions.nra.org/police-pistol-combat/</a>. You can also use your smart phone camera to scan the Quick Reader Code to the right or double click it with your computer cursor.

**Eligibility:** Open to any eligible law enforcement member as outlined in Police Pistol Combat Rule Section 2.4.

**Classification:** Competitors will be entered using their current NRA Police Pistol Combat Classification of High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, Marksman, or Classified. Competitors with expired Classifications and new shooters with no Classification or those without a Temporary Record Score Book will fire in the High Master Class as required by PPC Rule 19.2.

Competitors may check their current NRA Classification online at **LEcompetitions.nra.org.** You can also use your smart phone camera to scan the Quick Reader Code to the right or double click i your computer cursor.

**Registration:** Will be done on-site. Please complete the Registration Form at the end of this announcement and bring it with you to speed your registration process.

All competitors MUST present the following items during Registration:

- 1. Valid Department or Agency Identification
- 2. Current Classification Card or current Temporary Classification Book unless they have not fired in a PPC Tournament before.

**Categories:** There will be no categories used in these Tournaments.

**Awards & Tournament Results:** There are no awards in the Monthly Tournament. Results will be posted at **www.scpcl.org** and individually on request.

**Locations, Dates & Matches Offered & Match Information:** The first Match at **ALL** locations begins at 0900. Make sure you arrive in time to Check In and get your gear together.

- Depending on the date and location there MAY be up to three Matches offered. The table below lists the type of Match being fired each Match and the order being fired.
- For Duty Gun Division Matches you may fire <u>either</u> your Stock Service Semi-Automatic Pistol, Production Semi-Automatic Pistol or Stock Service Revolver.
- For Open Class Division Matches you may fire either your Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol or your Open Class Revolver.
- Where the same type of Match is offered twice you can fire the Match again using <u>another type</u> firearm from that Division. For instance if the first and second Match are both listed as Open Class Division Matches, you could fire your Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol in the first Match and your Open Class Division Revolver in the second Match or vice versa.

With permission of the Tournament Director you can fire the second Match with the same type handgun for <u>practice only</u> with the score not being listed on the Final Bulletin or for Awards or sent to NRA [PPC Rules only allow one Score for Record per match during a Tournament].

**Targets:** Official NRA B-27 targets and repair centers will be used.

**Scoring:** Competitor scoring will be used. Pursuant to PPC Rule 14.2, NO competitor will score their own target NOR may a competitor score the targets of a competitor from their same agency. If this cannot be avoided due to the Match's makeup contact a Match Official to score the targets. PPC Rules prohibit the use of plug-type scoring gauges. Overlays and Eagle Eyes may be used by competitors.



Score cards must be signed and are FINAL once signed so **PLEASE** double check the recorded hits and values BEFORE signing.

**Courses of Fire:** The Range Officer will announce the course of fire, shooting positions and time prior to the start of each Match and Stage. Time will start with a loaded gun in holster. No part of the competitor's hand may touch the gun or holster until the command to commence firing is given.

All loading will be with cartridges taken from the competitor's pocket, cartridge belt, mechanical loaders, or special pouch. To force reloading under time restraints, magazine loading is limited to 6 rounds per magazine. There is no limit on the number of magazines you may have but all used during the firing of a stage or string MUST be on your person. It is the competitors' responsibility to have sufficient ammunition in their possession to complete the Match being fired.

A conventional right or left-hand holster must be used. For safety reasons, shoulder, cross draw or holsters which require releasing by insertion of finger within the trigger guard will not be allowed. Holster cannot be tied down.

Optical Devices: No optical devices other than normal glasses worn for corrective eyesight or Sunglasses will be permitted on the range during Match firing for use by competitors. Use of a mechanical iris, eye patch or eye cover is also prohibited.

#### SCPCL Shotgun Match

The SCPCL Shotgun Match **uses Stages 3 and 4** of the NRA National Police Shooting Championships Police Shotgun Match 20 as found in the NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book. The stages are listed as Stage 1 & 2 below.

**Firearm:** Shotgun must be factory manufactured, 12 gauge, barrel length not to exceed 22 1/4 inches, metallic sights only, and no modifications. Barrel is to be cylinder or improved cylinder bore; constriction at the choke may not exceed 0.0149. Removable Chokes may be used. Shotgun barrels may checked for choke and inspected. All safety devices provided by the manufacturer must function as designed.

**Sling:** Shotgun may be equipped with a sling but it cannot have sling cuffs or other devises that attach to the arm. Slings may only be used in Stage 4.

**Ammunition:** Must be 12-gauge 1 ounce rifled slugs. Ammunition may be inspected and a sample shell may be required for disassembly and examination. Reloaded or sabot ammunition will not be allowed.

**Scoring Values:** Hits are scored using the B-27 target X, 10, 9, 8, and 7 Point face value scoring rings.

- **Stage 3:** 25 yards, from the shoulder, 5 rifled slugs fired at one B-27 target in 10 seconds. Gun must be held under the arm until the targets start to turn.
- **Stage 4:** 50 yards, from the shoulder, from either the kneeling or standing position, 5 rifled slugs fired at one B-27 target in 60 seconds. Gun stock <u>must</u> be held under the arm until targets start to turn. Sling <u>may</u> be used but cannot be wrapped around the arm or otherwise attached in any manner to the competitor's body <u>until</u> <u>after the targets start to turn</u>.

#### APPLIES TO ALL FIREARMS

Rule 3.1

Each competitor is responsible for their firearm and any which may be questionable should be submitted to the Tournament Director, Referee, or 3-Man Jury for decision prior to being used.

All standard safety features of the pistol must operate properly.

With respect to Sections 3.2 through 3.10, and in addition to the firearm specific regulations below, the following features are either Allowed or Prohibited on all firearms.

Action work to make a crisper and/or smoother trigger pull	Allowed

Ammunition: No high speed or Magnum ammunition will be allowed. Ammunition must be hand loaded or factory loaded to produce sufficient velocity to pass through the target AND the backer. Shots which do not pass through the target and the backer will be scored as misses.

Please take note that the NRA has made it clear that NO matter what APPROVED Replacement Sight is used, the sights MUST keep a Duty Gun Point of Aim/Point of Impact, not a competition set up, such as a Neck Hold, Shoulder Hold, or Head Hold.

A Duty Gun Point of Aim/Point of Impact sight set up requires the sights to be aligned on the X Ring/Center Mass to obtain a Hit in the X Ring/Center Mass area.

Pistols with competition sight set ups will be Disqualified, even if having already been used to fire a Match. Competitors may be required to allow their pistol to be test fired, or checked with a laser boresight to check the sight set up.

#### PRODUCTION SEMI-AUTOMATIC PISTOL

In addition to the specifications within Section 3.1, the following specifications apply for Production Semi-Automatic Pistols.

Firearm / Caliber: Pistols for this Division are approved by NRA Law Enforcement Competitions and listed on the Law Enforcement Competitions website. To be considered, must be a mass produced center-fire semi-automatic pistol made for police or military use (at least 1,000 pistols), unmodified stock catalog item in its original factory condition, and have a double, double/single, or striker type action. Must be capable of chambering and firing .35 caliber or larger ammunition, or FN 5.7 x 28 caliber ammunition. All double action semi-automatic pistols must fire the first shot of every stage double action.
