#### NRA Police Pistol Combat Tournament Announcement



The Mississippi Police Marksman Association and the Mississippi Law Enforcement Officers Training Academy is conducting monthly NRA Registered Police Pistol Combat Tournaments throughout 2019.

Tournaments will offer the NRA Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol Match, Open Class Revolver Match, Stock Service Semi-Automatic Pistol Match and Stock Service Revolver Match. These Tournaments are a great way for you to evaluate your skill level, identify needed training areas, and practice your handgun skills to keep you prepared for the ever-increasing dangers you face on the street and off duty.

NEW SHOOTERS - you do NOT need any fancy gear or guns to start shooting these matches. Just bring your duty handgun, four magazines, holster & magazine pouch. There is nothing to memorize, the course will be announced as you shoot just like the stages during a qualification and fellow officers will gladly help you out. You can even use your stock duty gun to fire the Open Class Division matches to get started and see how challenging and fun these matches are.

**Governing Rules:** Current NRA Police Pistol Combat Rules will govern throughout the Tournament. All competitors are encouraged to review the current PPC rules. If a competitor is uncertain about any equipment being eligible, they must contact the Tournament Director and NRA Match Supervisor for a decision prior to firing their first Match. The NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book is available on-line at <a href="https://lecompetitions.nra.org/police-pistol-combat/">https://lecompetitions.nra.org/police-pistol-combat/</a>. You can also use your smart phone camera to scan the Quick Reader Code to the right or double click it with your computer cursor.

**Eligibility:** Open to any eligible public or private law enforcement member as outlined in Police Pistol Combat Rule Section 2.4.

**Registration:** Registration deadline is 8:30 am on the day of the Tournament. Please complete the Registration Form on the last page and bring it with you to Check In.

**Tournament Fees:** Entry fees will be paid on the day of the match and payment can be made by cash or check. *Includes NRA Match Fees Where applicable*

Classification: Competitors will be entered using their current NRA Police Pistol Combat Classification of High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, Marksman, or Classified. Competitors with expired Classifications and new shooters with no Classification or those without a Temporary Record Score Book will fire in the High Master Class as required by PPC Rule 19.2. Competitors may check their current NRA Classification online at LEcompetitions.nra.org. You can also use your smart phone camera to scan the Quick Reader Code to the right or double click it with your computer cursor.

**Categories:** No categories will be used for these tournaments.

**Categories:** Category assignments will not be used at the monthly Tournaments.

**Targets:** Official NRA B-27 targets will be used.

**Scoring:** Competitor scoring will be used. Pursuant to PPC Rule 14.2, **NO** competitor will score their own target **NOR** may a competitor score the targets of a competitor from their same agency. If this cannot be avoided due to the Relay's makeup contact a Match Official to score the targets. PPC Rules prohibit the use of plug-type scoring gauges. Overlays and Eagle Eyes may be used by competitors.

Score cards must be signed and are FINAL once signed so **PLEASE** double check the recorded hits and values BEFORE signing.

**Result Bulletins:** Final Results will be posted immediately after the last match scores are finalized. Competitors may request a copy be sent to them by e-mail.

**Awards:** The First Place competitors of each Class will be awarded their Tournament Fee back. If there are less than three competitors in a Class, the competitors in that Class will combined with the next higher Class.

**Course of Fire Information:** The Range Officer will announce the course of fire, shooting positions and time prior to the start of each Match and Stage. Time will start with a loaded gun in holster. No part of the competitor's hand may touch the gun or holster until the command to commence firing is given.

All loading will be with cartridges taken from the competitor's pocket, cartridge belt, mechanical loaders, or special pouch. To force reloading under time restraints, magazine loading is limited to 6 rounds per magazine. There is no limit on the number of magazines you may have but all used during the firing of a stage or string MUST be on your person. It is the competitors' responsibility to have sufficient ammunition in their possession to complete the Match being fired.

A conventional right or left-hand holster must be used. For safety reasons, shoulder, cross draw or holsters which require releasing by insertion of finger within the trigger guard will not be allowed. Holster cannot be tied down.

Optical Devices: No optical devices other than normal glasses worn for corrective eyesight or Sunglasses will be permitted on the range during Match firing for use by competitors. Use of a mechanical iris, eye patch or eye cover is also prohibited.

#### NRA PPC Rule Book Quick View Firearm Matrix

#### APPLIES TO ALL FIREARMS Rule 3.1 Each competitor is responsible for their firearm and any which may be questionable should be submitted to the Tournament Director, Referee, or 3-Man Jury for decision prior to being used. All standard safety features of the pistol must operate properly. With respect to Sections 3.2 through 3.10, and in addition to the firearm specific regulations below, the following features are either Allowed or Prohibited on all firearms. Action work to make a crisper Allowed and/or smoother trigger pull Fixed or adjustable sights Allowed Sight Blackening Allowed Modification or change of stocks because of the size of a competitor's Allowed hand or to facilitate loading Internal modifications that would render the firearm less safe than Prohibited originally designed by the manufacturer Any external modifications, except Prohibited those allowed within each rule Front sight extending beyond Prohibited muzzle Compensators, barrel venting, or Prohibited barrel porting Ammunition: No high speed or Magnum ammunition will be allowed. Ammunition must be hand loaded or factory loaded to produce sufficient velocity to pass through the target AND the backer. Shots which do not pass through the target and the backer will be scored as misses.
