These Tournaments are a great way for you to evaluate your skill level, identify needed training areas, improve your qualification scores, and practice your handgun skills to keep you prepared for the ever-increasing dangers you face on the street and off duty.

## ~ NEW SHOOTERS ~

You do NOT need any fancy gear or guns to start shooting these matches. Just bring your duty handgun, three magazines, holster & magazine pouch. There is nothing to memorize, the course will be announced as you shoot just like the stages during a qualification and fellow officers will gladly help you out. You can even use your stock duty gun to fire the Open Class Division Matches if you have four magazines. This will let you see what the other matches are like and how challenging and fun these matches are.

Matches Offered: We are pleased to offer: Stock Service Semi-Automatic Pistol Match 14,

Production Pistol Match 23, Stock Service Revolver Match 7, Distinguished Production Match 24, Distinguished Semi-Automatic Pistol Match 18, Distinguished Revolver Match 17, Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol Matches 8 through 12, Open Class Revolver Matches 1 through 5, and the SCPCL Shotgun Match.

Team Matches will also be offered but will be non-fired paper matches so will team scores will not be sent to NRA Law Enforcement Competitions.

Dates: Friday May 3<sup>th</sup> and Saturday May 4<sup>th</sup> with practice relays on Thursday May 2<sup>nd</sup>.

**Governing Rules:** Current NRA Police Pistol Combat Rules will govern throughout the Tournament. All competitors are encouraged to review the current PPC rules. The NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book is available on-line at **ppc.nra.org** or use your smart phone camera to scan this Quick Reader Code or Double Click your cursor on it.



**SAFETY:** All safety rules of the NRA, SCCJA, and the SCPCL will be enforced. Safety violations will be grounds for removal from the firing line. Major violations can cause disqualification. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed on the South Carolina Criminal Justice Academy property.

**Individual Eligibility:** Open to any eligible law enforcement member as outlined in Police Pistol Combat Rule Section 2.4. These include active and retired Law Enforcement Officers, and <u>full time</u> Police Firearms Instructors, Transit Police, Penal Institution Guards, Industrial Police which includes Bank Guards and Armored and Express Company Guards, and Military Police. Federal Flight Deck Officers who hold valid certifications are also eligible.

NRA Membership is not required, but encouraged. Discounted NRA Membership Forms for Law Enforcement Officers will be available during the Tournament.

Make sure you bring your agency credentials or other paperwork showing your eligibility with you to show when you check in.

**Team Eligibility**: Team Matches will be Paper Matches. Teams will consist of two or four firing members and a Team Captain. The Team Captain may be a competing member of the team. Police Pistol Combat Rule 2.8 requires that all team members <u>must be from the same agency</u>. Membership can include officers retired from the agency if they are not now employed by another eligible agency. Eligible Military competitors who are also regular full time law enforcement, industrial law enforcement, or reserve/auxiliary law enforcement must sign up with other members <u>from their law enforcement agency</u>. No "pick-up" teams are allowed.

**Registration:** You may register on-site but <u>Pre-Registration is highly recommended</u> to be certain of a slot. <u>All</u> Individual Registrations must be received by 0800 on Thursday May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2019. To register please complete the Competitor Registration Form found at the end of this announcement and follow the submission instructions listed.

**Classification:** Competitors will be entered using their current NRA Police Pistol Combat Classification of High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, Marksman, or Classified. Competitors with expired Classifications and **new shooters** with no Classification or those without a Temporary Record Score Book will fire in the High Master Class as required by PPC Rule 19.2.

You can check your current NRA Classification at **LEcompetitions.nra.org** or by using your smart phone camera to scan the Quick Reader Code to the right or Double Clicking on it.



**Tournament Fees:** Entry fees will be collected on the day of the Tournament with payment made in cash or by check. Where applicable, fees include NRA Match Fees

Shooters are also encouraged to bring a competitor who has never competed in the Palmetto State Regional before. For those persons bringing a new competitor, both the sponsor and the new attendee will **get ten dollars off of the package price**. Let us know when you register at the range and the credit will be given. If you have Pre- Registered, the fees will be adjusted accordingly and refunded.

Select the Special Package Deal which allows you to fire any or all of the offered Individual Matches for a flat fee of \$ 170.00 or sign up for the Individual Matches you wish to fire. The Thursday Open Class Practice Relay and Team Fees are not included in the Package Deal.

**Firearm Awards:** At least one gun will be awarded by drawing at the Awards Banquet. You must have participated in all matches to be eligible for this drawing and be present to win. Any shooter who wins a firearm as a match winner is not eligible for the drawing. Class winners will be awarded trophies in the Stock Service Gun Matches. Only one gun per competitor will be awarded. Your averaged Classification will determine Class Awards for Open Class 3000 aggregate.

Individual Class winners of the firearms will drop to the next eligible shooter if the Class winner has won a gun in another match. If a competitor wins a gun as the Overall Championship and then wins

the Open Class 3000 Aggregate, the firearm in the Open Class 3000 Aggregate will be awarded to the number two shooter in that Class. This way a person need not place first in their Class to win a firearm.

### **Firearms Winners:**

<u>Out of State Winners</u>: By federal law, firearms must be shipped to your local FFL dealer for ultimate transfer to you. Firearms will be shipped upon receipt of a valid, signed in ink, copy of your dealers FFL license and payment for shipping, which is your responsibility.

<u>In State Winners</u>: Federal and state law require a NICS background check to approve the transfer of a firearm to you, before you receive your firearm. NICS checks will be made at the banquet after your 4473's are correctly filled out with all the required information and a valid I.D. Delayed NICS responses will require you to pick up your firearm at a later date. NO EXCEPTIONS.

**Saturday Night Barbeque:** Will begin at 6:00 pm with the Awards Presentation following the meal. For those shooters who win more than one match, cash, trophies and other awards may be given.

**Area Attractions:** Each shooter's packet will contain certificates and coupons for local attractions and restaurants and shooters are encouraged to bring their families to enjoy spring in South Carolina's Capital. There are numerous attractions in the area to include the Riverbanks Zoo Gardens and the State Museum.

Targets: Official NRA B-27 Targets will be used.

**Scoring:** Competitor scoring will be used by passing your scorecards to the competitor on your right who will score the targets of the competitor to their left. Pursuant to PPC Rule 14.2, **NO** competitor will score their own target **NOR** may a competitor score the targets of a competitor from their same agency. If this cannot be avoided due to the Relay's makeup contact a Match Official to score the targets. PPC Rules prohibit the use of plug-type scoring gauges. Overlays and Eagle Eyes may be used by competitors.

**Score Cards:** All score cards <u>must</u> be signed and are FINAL once signed so **PLEASE** double check the recorded hits and values BEFORE signing. Once a score card is signed and turned in, <u>only</u> a Match Official can alter the card and will initial the change.

Sighting Shots: No sighting shots are allowed.

### **Course of Fire Information:**

The Range Officer will announce the course of fire, shooting positions and time prior to the start of each Match and Stage. Time will start with a loaded gun in holster. No part of the competitor's hand may touch the gun or holster until the command to commence firing is given.

All loading will be with cartridges taken from the competitor's pocket, cartridge belt, mechanical loaders, or special pouch. To force reloading under time restraints, magazine loading is limited to 6 rounds per magazine. There is no limit on the number of magazines you may have but all used during the firing of a stage or string MUST be on your person. It is the competitors' responsibility to have sufficient ammunition in their possession to complete the Match being fired.

Firing Method: Matches or stages designated as double action must be fired double action. Matches or stages designated as single action may be fired either single or double action. All double action semi-automatic pistols must fire the first shot of every stage double action except at the 50 yard line.

A conventional right or left-hand holster must be used. For safety reasons, shoulder, cross draw or holsters which require releasing by insertion of finger within the trigger guard will not be allowed. Holster cannot be tied down.

Optical Devices: No optical devices other than normal glasses worn for corrective eyesight or Sunglasses will be permitted on the range during Match firing for use by competitors. Use of a mechanical iris, eye patch or eye cover is also prohibited.

**Firearms, Ammunition & Holsters Allowed:** Please see NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book Section 3 for Firearm requirements and the *NRA PPC Rule Book Quick View Firearm Matrix* charts reproduced on the next pages.

Any questions concerning firearms, ammunition or holsters should be directed to Tournament Officials <u>prior</u> to commencement of that shooter's relay. Where applicable, triggers will be weighed, and ammo inspected prior to match.

Please take note that for **Distinguished Production Pistol Match 24**, the NRA requires ALL pistols to be inspected, certified as eligible as a Production Pistol, the trigger weighed and the sights checked for approval. <u>You</u> will have to complete the handgun information section about your Production Pistol and Sights on the NRA Distinguished Production Scorecard. So make sure you know the Production Pistol Approval Number in PPC Bulletin 14-1 for your pistol AND if you changed the original sights, the Sight Approval Number listed in PPC Bulletin 16-1.

To see PPC Bulletins 14-1 and 16-1 you can use your smart phone camera to scan the Quick Reader Code or double click it with your computer cursor to pull up the PPC information page and then scroll down the page to see the PPC Bulletins.


