*Saturday June 22<sup>nd</sup> and Sunday June 23<sup>rd</sup>*

The Riverside Sheriff and the Riverside Sheriff Reserve are conducting NRA Registered Police Pistol Combat Tournaments at the Ben Clark Public Safety Training Center on the same weekend and simultaneously as a “Postal Tournament” at the Sacramento County Sheriff Range.

These Tournaments are a great way for you to evaluate your skill level, identify needed training areas, and practice your handgun skills to keep you prepared for the ever-increasing dangers you face on the street and off duty.

**First Time Shooters**

You do NOT need any fancy gear or guns to start shooting these matches. Just bring your duty handgun, four magazines, holster & magazine pouch. There is nothing to memorize, the course will be announced as you shoot just like the stages during a qualification and fellow officers will gladly help you out. You can even use your stock duty gun to fire the Open Class Division matches to get started and see how challenging and fun these matches are.

**Dates:** Saturday June 22<sup>nd</sup> and Sunday June 23<sup>rd</sup>

The Riverside Sheriff Police Pistol Combat Tournament will be conducted first each day and then the Riverside Sheriff Reserve Tournament will be fired after the first Tournament’s relays have completed. By having back-to-back Tournaments shooters can compete in two Tournaments in one day for record.

**Matches Offered:** Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol Matches 8 through 12  
Open Class Revolver Matches 1 through 5  
Stock Service Semi-Automatic Pistol Match 14  
Stock Service Revolver Match 7

Shooters can also sign up to fire the California Distinguished Revolver, Distinguished Semi-Automatic Pistol, and Production Semi-Automatic Pistol Matches.

**Governing Rules:** Current NRA Police Pistol Combat Rules will govern throughout the Tournament. All competitors are encouraged to review the current PPC rules. The NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book is available on-line at [ppc.nra.org](http://ppc.nra.org) or use your smart phone camera to scan the Quick Reader Code or place your cursor on it and press CTRL and CLICK.



**Eligibility:** Open to any eligible law enforcement member as outlined in Police Pistol Combat Rule Section 2.4.

**Registration:** Will be done on-site. Please complete the Registration Form at the end of this announcement and bring it with you to speed your registration process.

All competitors MUST present the following items during Registration:

1. Valid Department or Agency Identification
2. Current Classification Card or current Temporary Classification Book unless they have not fired in a PPC Tournament before.

- 1100: Fire either the NRA Stock Service Revolver Match 7 or Stock Service Semi-Automatic Pistol Match 14
- 1130: Fire either the California Distinguished Revolver or Semi-Auto Distinguished Match
- 1400: Fire either the NRA Stock Service Revolver Match 7 or Stock Service Semi-Automatic Pistol Match 14
- 1430: Fire either the California Distinguished Revolver, Distinguished Semi-Auto, or Distinguished Production Match

**Classification:** Competitors will be entered using their current NRA Police Pistol Combat Classification of High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, Marksman, or Classified. Competitors with expired Classifications and **new shooters** with no Classification or those without a Temporary Record Score Book will fire in the High Master Class as required by PPC Rule 19.2.

You can check your current NRA Classification at [LEcompetitions.nra.org](http://LEcompetitions.nra.org) or by using your smart phone camera to scan the Quick Reader Code to the right or place your computer cursor on it and or place your cursor on it and press CTRL and CLICK.



**Categories:** There will be no categories used in these Tournaments.

**Targets:** Official NRA B-27 targets will be used.

**Scoring:** Competitor scoring will be used. Pursuant to PPC Rule 14.2, **NO** competitor will score their own target **NOR** may a competitor score the targets of a competitor from their same agency. If this cannot be avoided due to the Relay's makeup contact a Match Official to score the targets. PPC Rules prohibit the use of plug-type scoring gauges. Overlays and Eagle Eyes may be used by competitors.

Score cards must be signed and are FINAL once signed so **PLEASE** double check the recorded hits and values BEFORE signing.

**Courses of Fire:** The Range Officer will announce the course of fire, shooting positions and time prior to the start of each Match and Stage. Time will start with a loaded gun in holster. No part of the competitor's hand may touch the gun or holster until the command to commence firing is given.

All loading will be with cartridges taken from the competitor's pocket, cartridge belt, mechanical loaders, or special pouch. To force reloading under time restraints, magazine loading is limited to 6 rounds per magazine. There is no limit on the number of magazines you may have but all used during the firing of a stage or string **MUST** be on your person. It is the competitors' responsibility to have sufficient ammunition in their possession to complete the Match being fired.

A conventional right or left-hand holster must be used. For safety reasons, shoulder, cross draw or holsters which require releasing by insertion of finger within the trigger guard will not be allowed. Holster cannot be tied down.

Optical Devices: No optical devices other than normal glasses worn for corrective eyesight or Sunglasses will be permitted on the range during Match firing for use by competitors. Use of a mechanical iris, eye patch or eye cover is also prohibited.

If a competitor is uncertain about any equipment being eligible, they must contact the Tournament Director or NRA Match Supervisor for a decision prior to firing the first Match.

**Firearms & Ammunition Allowed:** Please see NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book Sections 3.1, 3.2, 3.3, 3.6 and 3.7 and the *NRA PPC rule Book Quick View Matrix* reproduced below.

<b>APPLIES TO ALL FIREARMS</b>		Rule 3.1
<p>Each competitor is responsible for their firearm and any which may be questionable should be submitted to the Tournament Director, Referee, or 3-Man Jury for decision prior to being used.</p> <p>All standard safety features of the pistol must operate properly.</p> <p>With respect to Sections 3.2 through 3.10, and in addition to the firearm specific regulations below, the following features are either Allowed or Prohibited on all firearms.</p>		
Action work to make a crisper and/or smoother trigger pull	Allowed	
Fixed or adjustable sights	Allowed	
Sight Blackening	Allowed	
Modification or change of stocks because of the size of a competitor's hand or to facilitate loading	Allowed	
Internal modifications that would render the firearm less safe than originally designed by the manufacturer	Prohibited	
Any external modifications, except those allowed within each rule	Prohibited	
Front sight extending beyond muzzle	Prohibited	
Compensators, barrel venting, or barrel porting	Prohibited	
<p>Ammunition: No high speed or Magnum ammunition will be allowed. Ammunition must be hand loaded or factory loaded to produce sufficient velocity to pass through the target AND the backer. Shots which do not pass through the target and the backer will be scored as misses.</p>

<p>Firearm / Caliber: Center-fire pistols of .35 caliber or larger. All double action semi-automatic pistols must fire the first shot of every stage double action except at the 50 yard line.</p>
