The Montana Police Pistol Combat League is conducting a NRA Approved Police Pistol Combat Tournament at the Toole County Sheriff's Department Range on Sunday, June 23rd.

We will be offering NRA Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol Matches 1 through 12, Open Class Revolver Matches 1 through 5, Production Pistol Match 23, Production Duty Optic Pistol Match 25, Stock Service Semi-Automatic Pistol Match 14 and Stock Service Revolver Match 7.

You do NOT need any fancy gear or guns to start shooting these matches. Just bring your duty handgun, four magazines, holster & magazine pouch. There is nothing to memorize, the course will be announced as you shoot just like the stages during a qualification and fellow officers will gladly help you out. You can even use your stock duty gun to fire the Open Class Division matches to get started and see how challenging and fun these matches are.

Governing Rules: Current NRA Police Pistol Combat Rules will govern throughout the Tournament. All competitors are encouraged to review the current PPC rules. The NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book is available on-line at **ppc.nra.org** or use your smart phone camera to scan this Quick Reader Code or Double Click your cursor on it.



Eligibility: Open to any eligible law enforcement member as outlined in Police Pistol Combat Rule Section 2.4. These include active and retired Law Enforcement Officers, and <u>full time</u> Police Firearms Instructors, Transit Police, Penal Institution Guards, Industrial Police which includes Bank Guards and Armored and Express Company Guards, and Military Police. Federal Flight Deck Officers who hold valid certifications are also eligible.

NRA Membership is <u>not required</u> for any NRA competitions but is encouraged. A special law enforcement discount form for NRA Membership and Renewal will be available at check in.

Registration: Registrations will be done onsite. Please complete the Registration Form on the last page and bring it with you to speed the registration process.

Please make sure you bring your Department or Agency Identification current or retired ID and current NRA PPC Classification Card or Temporary Classification Book if you have one. See the Classification section for more information.

Classification: Competitors will be entered using their current NRA Police Pistol Combat Classification of High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, Marksman, or Classified. Competitors with expired Classifications and **new shooters** with no Classification or those without a Temporary Record Score Book will fire in the High Master Class as required by PPC Rule 19.2.

You can check your current NRA Classification at **LEcompetitions.nra.org** or by using your smart phone camera to scan the Quick Reader Code to the right or place your computer cursor on it and press the CTRL Key and Click your cursor on it.



Categories: There will be no categories used in these Tournaments.

Awards: There will be NO Awards in this Tournament.

Relay Times: We will begin at 0900 with the Open Class Division Matches. Please MAKE sure you arrive by 0845 with your completed Registration Form and are ready to shoot by 0855.

Targets: Official NRA B-27 targets will be used. **Competitors MUST bring their own staple guns and staples.**

Scoring: Competitor scoring will be used. Pursuant to PPC Rule 14.2, **NO** competitor will score their own target **NOR** may a competitor score the targets of a competitor from their same agency. If this cannot be avoided due to the Relay's makeup contact a Match Official to score the targets. PPC Rules prohibit the use of plug-type scoring gauges. Overlays and Eagle Eyes may be used by competitors.



Score cards must be signed and are FINAL once signed so **PLEASE** double check the recorded hits and values BEFORE signing.

Refires: See NRA PPC Rule Section 9

Challenges: Target scoring Challenges will follow PPC Rule 16.1 with a Challenge Fee of \$3.00 which will be returned to the competitor if the Challenge is upheld. The three-person jury will decide Challenges.

Result Bulletins: Final Result Bulletins will be provided following PPC Rule 11.14.

Course of Fire Information:

The Range Officer will announce the course of fire, shooting positions and time prior to the start of each Match and Stage. Time will start with a loaded gun in holster. No part of the competitor's hand may touch the gun or holster until the command to commence firing is given. All loading will be with cartridges taken from the competitor's pocket, cartridge belt, mechanical loaders, or special pouch. To force reloading under time restraints, magazine loading is limited to 6 rounds per magazine. There is no limit on the number of magazines you may have but all used during the firing of a stage or string MUST be on your person. It is the competitors'

responsibility to have sufficient ammunition in their possession to complete the Match being fired.

A conventional right or left-hand holster must be used. For safety reasons, shoulder, cross draw or holsters which require releasing by insertion of finger within the trigger guard will not be allowed. Holster cannot be tied down.

Optical Devices: No optical devices other than normal glasses worn for corrective eyesight or Sunglasses will be permitted on the range during Match firing for use by competitors. Use of a mechanical iris, eye patch or eye cover is also prohibited.

In addition to the specifications within Section 3.1, and 3.10, the following specifications apply for Production Duty Optic Pistols.

Firearm / Caliber: Pistols meeting the specifications for Production Pistols in Section 3.10 and are listed as Approved in Police Pistol Combat Bulletin 14.1 may be equipped with an Approved non-magnified optic suitable for duty use.

The Duty Optic must be listed as Approved by NRA Law Enforcement Competitions in Police Pistol Combat Bullet 19.1 on the Law Enforcement Competitions website.

To be considered for approval, Duty Optics must mount without any modification to the handgun as originally manufactured. Swapping the original slide to an aftermarket slide with optic mount cuts is <u>not</u> allowed since the handgun is no longer as originally manufactured.

The pistol should have co-witnessed front and rear sights, but the rear sight may be removed to mount the Duty Optic or to use a stock Optic Ready Plate.

All Other Specifications are the same as Production Pistols

→ Your Pistol must be listed as approved for Production Pistol Matches in online PPC Bulletin 14-1.

If you changed the original factory sights, the replacement sights must be listed as Approved Duty Type Sights in PPC Bulletin 16-1.

Your Duty Optic MUST be listed as approved in online PPC Bulletin 19-1.
