The members of the NYPD Pistol Team are conducting an NRA Sanctioned Police Pistol Combat Approved Tournaments at the Monroe-Chester Sportsman Club. We are also running several other matches sanctioned by the New York Police Combat Association.

These Tournaments are a great way for you to evaluate your skill level, identify needed training areas, improve your qualification scores, and practice your handgun skills to keep you prepared for the ever-increasing dangers you face on the street, off duty, or as a retired officer.

~ NEW SHOOTERS ~

You do NOT need any fancy gear or guns to start shooting these matches. Just bring your duty handgun, three magazines, holster & magazine pouch. There is nothing to memorize, the course will be announced as you shoot just like the stages during a qualification and fellow officers will gladly help you out. You can even use your stock duty gun to fire the Open Class Division Matches if you have four magazines. This will let you see what the other matches are like and how challenging and fun these matches are.

**Directions:** Route 17 west to Exit 130. Make a left at the light. Go past the first gas station and bear right to the next light. Make a left at the LIGHT. Go two lights to Route 5, Lakes Road. Make a right on Lakes Road. Go approximately 3 miles to Laroe Road (at the end of the lake on your left, follow the hospital signs to range). Make a right on Laroe Road and go to Gibson Hill Road, approximately 1.5 mile. Make a left on Gibson Hill Road. Range is on the right hand side, in approximately 1 mile.

**Matches Offered:** NRA's Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol Match 8 thru 12, Open Class Revolver Matches 1 thru 5, Stock Service Semi-Automatic Pistol Match 14, Stock Service Revolver Match 7, and the NYPCA Semi-Auto Match.

**Lunch:** Food and drink will be provided for competitors.

**Governing Rules:** Current NRA Police Pistol Combat Rules will govern throughout the Tournament. All competitors are encouraged to review the current PPC rules. The NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book is available on-line at [ppc.nra.org](http://ppc.nra.org) or use your smart phone camera to scan the Quick Reader Code or Double Click your cursor on it.



**Eligibility:** Open to any eligible law enforcement member as outlined in Police Pistol Combat Rule Section 2.4. These include active and retired Law Enforcement Officers, and full time Police Firearms Instructors, Transit Police, Penal Institution Guards, Industrial Police which includes Bank Guards and Armored and Express Company Guards, and Military Police. Federal Flight Deck Officers who hold valid certifications are also eligible.

NRA Membership is not required for any NRA competitions but is encouraged. A special law enforcement discount form for NRA Membership and Renewal will be available at check in.

**Tournament Fees:** Entry fees will be collected on the day of the Tournament with payment made in cash or by check. Checks must be made payable to **NYPD Pistol Team**. Where applicable, fees include NRA Match Fees unless noted otherwise.

- NRA Open Class Division Match \$ 15.00  
*Fire either Open Class Revolver Matches 1-5 or Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol Matches 8 thru 12*  
*If you fire an Open Class Match on Saturday you can fire a second Open Class Match on Sunday for an additional \$ 10.00. However, if you fire the same type Open Class Handgun on Sunday as you did on Saturday, for example you fire the Open Class Revolver Match both days, your first match score will be sent to NRA as your record score as PPC Rules only allow one Score for Record per match during a Tournament. If you fire the Open Class Revolver Match one day and the Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol the other day, both scores will count and be sent to NRA.*
- NRA Stock Semi-Auto and Service Revolver Matches \$ 5.00
- NYPCA Semi-Auto Match *This is not a Sanctioned NRA Match* \$ 5.00

**Registration:** Advanced Registration is recommended as there will only be 15 shooters per Relay with those who register in advance having priority squadding over walk-ons. Please see the last page for Advanced Registration instructions.

On-site Registration and Check-In of Advanced Registration competitors will begin at 0915 the day of the Tournament. Make sure you allow time to register and get your gear together prior to the 1000 first match start time.

**Classification:** Competitors will be entered using their current NRA Police Pistol Combat Classification of High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, Marksman, or Classified. Competitors with expired Classifications and **new shooters** with no Classification or those without a Temporary Record Score Book will fire in the High Master Class as required by PPC Rule 19.2.

You can check your current NRA Classification at [LEcompetitions.nra.org](http://LEcompetitions.nra.org) or by using your smart phone camera to scan the Quick Reader Code to the right or CTRL + CLICK on it with your computer cursor.



**Categories:** There will be no categories used in these Tournaments.

**Awards Schedule:** There are no cash or product prizes for this Tournament.

**Match & Relay Schedule:** The first Relay will begin at 1000 with the NRA Open Class Division, then relays of the NYPCA Service Weapon Match and NYPCA Semi-Auto Match. The Open Class Match will be squadded.

**Targets:** Official NRA B-27 targets will be used.

**Scoring:** Competitor scoring will be used. Pursuant to PPC Rule 14.2, **NO** competitor will score their own target NOR may a competitor score the targets of a competitor from their same agency. If this cannot be avoided due to the Relay's makeup contact a Tournament Official to score the targets.

PPC Rules prohibit the use of plug-type scoring gauges. Overlays and Eagle Eyes may be used by



competitors. Score cards must be signed and are FINAL once signed so **PLEASE** double check the recorded hits and values BEFORE signing.

**Result Bulletins:** Final Result Bulletins will be provided.

**Awards Schedule:** There are no cash or product prizes for this Tournament.

**Course of Fire Information:** The Range Officer will announce the course of fire, shooting positions and time prior to the start of each Match and Stage. Time will start with a loaded gun in holster. No part of the competitor's hand may touch the gun or holster until the command to commence firing is given.

All loading will be with cartridges taken from the competitor's pocket, cartridge belt, mechanical loaders, or special pouch. To force reloading under time restraints, magazine loading is limited to 6 rounds per magazine. There is no limit on the number of magazines you have but all used during the firing of a stage or string MUST be on your person. It is the competitors' responsibility to have sufficient ammunition in their possession to complete the Match being fired.

A conventional right or left-hand holster must be used. For safety reasons, shoulder, cross draw or holsters which require releasing by insertion of finger within the trigger guard will not be allowed. Holster cannot be tied down.


Optical Devices: No optical devices other than normal glasses worn for corrective eyesight or Sunglasses will be permitted on the range during Match firing for use by competitors. Use of a mechanical iris, eye patch or eye cover is also prohibited.

Match 5	Match 12	Stage 1: 7 yards, 12 shots double action standing without support. Time limit 20 seconds including time to reload.  Stage 2: 25 yards, 6 shots kneeling; 6 shots standing left handed with support from behind left side of barricade, and 6 shots standing right handed with support from behind right side of barricade. Time limit 12 seconds.</p>

<b>APPLIES TO ALL FIREARMS</b>		Rule 3.1
<p>Each competitor is responsible for their firearm and any which may be questionable should be submitted to the Tournament Director, Referee, or 3-Man Jury for decision prior to being used.</p> <p>All standard safety features of the pistol must operate properly.</p> <p>With respect to Sections 3.2 through 3.10, and in addition to the firearm specific regulations below, the following features are either Allowed or Prohibited on all firearms.</p>		
Action work to make a crisper and/or smoother trigger pull	Allowed	
Fixed or adjustable sights	Allowed	
Sight Blackening	Allowed	
Modification or change of stocks because of the size of a competitor's hand or to facilitate loading	Allowed	
Internal modifications that would render the firearm less safe than originally designed by the manufacturer	Prohibited	
Any external modifications, except those allowed within each rule	Prohibited	
Front sight extending beyond muzzle	Prohibited

<p>Ammunition: No high speed or Magnum ammunition will be allowed. Ammunition must be hand loaded or factory loaded to produce sufficient velocity to pass through the target AND the backer. Shots which do not pass through the target and the backer will be scored as misses.</p>
