We will be conducting the Michigan State Championship Police Pistol Combat Tournament on Saturday August 24th, 2019.

These Tournaments are also a great way for <u>all of us</u> experienced Police Pistol Combat Shooters to bring a new shooter and expose them to what the PPC program is all about and show them how it can help them improve their qualification scores and practice their handgun skills that may literally help save their life or the life of our citizens. While we will not be running any NRA Duty Gun Matches, they can fire in the Open Class Division matches with their duty gun or other service type handgun. They just need their duty gear and four magazines.

Experienced civilian shooters are welcome to come out and participate as well. These matches are a great way to get some practice with your personal protection handgun, see how those new sights are working, check the zero on those new rounds you are trying.

So let's all take on the *Bring a New Shooter Challenge* and bring a fellow officer, deputy, or civilian shooter with us to see how challenging and fun these matches are.

Registration: Registration can be done on-site from 0900 to 1300. Please complete the Registration Form on the last page and bring it with you to speed your Registration and Check In. Team Registrations will be done on-site separately.

Governing Rules: Current NRA Police Pistol Combat Rules will govern throughout the Tournament. All competitors are encouraged to review the current PPC rules. The NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book is available on-line at **ppc.nra.org**. Or use your smart phone camera to scan this Quick Reader Code. You can also use your computer by Pressing the CTRL Key and Click your cursor on the barcode at the same time.



Eligibility: All competitors should be familiar with NRA Open Class Division courses of fire found later in this announcement.

■ Law Enforcement Members: Open to any eligible law enforcement member as outlined in Police Pistol Combat Rule Section 2.4. These include active and retired Law Enforcement Officers, and <u>full time</u> Police

Firearms Instructors, Transit Police, Penal Institution Guards, Industrial Police, which includes Bank Guards and Armored and Express Company Guards, and Military Police. Federal Flight Deck Officers who hold valid certifications are also eligible.

 Civilian participants who are familiar with the NRA Open Class Division courses of fire and range operations are welcome to participate.

NRA Membership: Membership is <u>not required</u> for any NRA competitions but is encouraged. A special law enforcement discount form for NRA Membership and Renewal will be available at check in for law enforcement members.

Team Match Eligibility: Teams will consist of two firing members and a Team Captain. The Team Captain may be a competing member of the team. All team members <u>must be from the same agency</u>. Membership can include officers retired from the agency if they are not now employed by another eligible agency. Eligible Military competitors who are also regular full time law enforcement, industrial law enforcement, or reserve/auxiliary law enforcement must sign up with other members <u>from their law enforcement agency</u>. No "pick-up" teams are allowed.

Individual Classification: Competitors will be entered using their current NRA Police Pistol Combat Classification of High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, Marksman, or Classified. Competitors with expired Classifications, new shooters with no Classification, or those without a Temporary Record Score Book will be registered in the High Master Class as required by PPC Rule 19.2. Competitors may check their current NRA Classification at LEcompetitions.nra.org or by scanning this Quick Reader Code with your Smart Phone's Camera.



Team Classification: The teams will be Classified based on the Individual Classifications of each Team Member following NRA PPC Rule 19.16.

Two Officer Open Class Revolver and Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol Team Matches These will be non-fired matches using each team member's individual Open Class score. Since they are non-fired, scores will not be sent to NRA Law Enforcement Competitions.

Relay Times: The first Match each day starts promptly at 0900 with relays running until 1600.

Award Schedule: Announced On-site **Targets:** Official NRA B-27 targets.

Scoring: Competitor scoring will be used. Pursuant to PPC Rule 14.2, **NO** competitor will score their own target **NOR** may a competitor score the targets of a competitor from their same agency. If this cannot be avoided due to the Relay's makeup contact a Tournament Official to score the targets.

PPC Rules prohibit the use of plug-type scoring gauges. Overlays and Eagle Eyes may be used by competitors. Score cards must be signed and are FINAL once signed so **PLEASE** double check the recorded hits and values BEFORE signing. Score cards will be collected and returned to the Statistical Office following each match.

Challenges: If the competitor wants to Challenge the scoring, they must inform the Chief Range Officer immediately and pay a Challenge Fee of \$ 4.00. The fee will be refunded if the Challenge is ruled in favor of the shooter. Challenges will be processed following NRA PPC Rule 16.1. Challenges to Preliminary Bulletins must be made within one hour of the Posting Time.

Result Bulletins: Final Result Bulletins will be provided to all competitors.

Refires: No re-fires will be allowed for defective guns or ammunition, or for other malfunctions of the shooters equipment. Disabled Handguns will be handled following PPC Rule 9.1.

Courses of Fire: The Range Officer will announce the course of fire, shooting positions and time prior to the start of each Match and Stage. Time will start with a loaded gun in holster. No part of the competitor's hand may touch the gun or holster until the command to commence firing is given.

All loading will be with cartridges taken from the competitor's pocket, cartridge belt, mechanical loaders, or special pouch. To force reloading under time restraints, magazine loading is limited to 6 rounds per magazine. There is no limit on the number of magazines you have but all used during the firing of a stage or string MUST be on your person. It is the competitors' responsibility to have sufficient ammunition in their possession to complete the Match being fired.

A conventional right or left-hand holster must be used. For safety reasons, shoulder, cross draw or holsters which require releasing by insertion of finger within the trigger guard will not be allowed. Holster cannot be tied down.

Optical Devices: No optical devices other than normal glasses worn for corrective eyesight or Sunglasses will be permitted on the range during Match firing for use by competitors. Use of a mechanical iris, eye patch or eye cover is also prohibited.

Match 3	Match 10	At 50 yards, 24 rounds fired; 6 shots sitting; 6 shots prone; 6 shots standing left handed with support from behind left side of barricade; 6 shots standing right handed with support from behind right side of barricade. Match 4	Match 11	At 25 yards, 24 rounds fired in two stages of 12 shots each fired double action, standing without support. Time limit 35 seconds for each 12-shot stage including time to reload.

Match 6	Match 13	Match 6 is the Aggregate of the shooter's Open Class Revolver Match 1 through Match 5 scores with a total possible score of 1500 points.
		Match 13 is the Aggregate of the shooter's Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol Match 8 through 12 scores with a total possible score of 1500 points.

Firearms & Ammunition Allowed: Please see NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book Section 3 and the *PPC rule Book Quick View Matrix* reproduced below. If a competitor is uncertain about any equipment being eligible they must contact the Tournament Director or NRA Match Supervisor for a decision prior to firing the first Match.

Each competitor is responsible for their firearm and any which may be questionable should be submitted to the Tournament Director, Referee, or 3-Man Jury for decision prior to being used.

With respect to Sections 3.2 through 3.10, and in addition to the firearm specific regulations below, the following features are either Allowed or Prohibited on all firearms.		
Action work to make a crisper and/or smoother trigger pull	Allowed

Modification or change of stocks because of the size of a competitor's hand or to facilitate loading	Allowed	
Internal modifications that would render the firearm less safe than originally designed by the manufacturer	Prohibited

Compensators, barrel venting, or barrel porting	Prohibited	
Ammunition: No high speed or Magnum ammunition will be allowed. Ammunition must be hand loaded or factory loaded to produce sufficient velocity to pass through the target AND the backer. Shots which do not pass through the target and the backer will be scored as misses.
