2020 TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE

The Marysville Rifle Club PPC Shooters are happy to announce that we will be conducting NRA Sanctioned Police Pistol Combat Tournaments throughout 2020.

All Tournaments will feature the NRA PPC Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol and Open Class Revolver Matches and during some Tournaments we will run other matches such as NRA Police Pistol Combat Stock Duty Gun Matches.

These matches are a great way for you to train, evaluate your skill level, get some practice, have fun, and hone your handgun skills to keep you prepared for the ever-increasing dangers you face on the street and off duty.

NEW SHOOTERS - you DO NOT need an Open Class Gun to shoot these matches or any fancy gear. Just bring your duty handgun, four magazines, holster & magazine pouch and you can shoot. There is nothing to memorize, the Range Officer will announce the course as you shoot just like the stages during a qualification and folks will gladly help you out. TIME: The Club gate will be opened at 8:00 am. Sign-up begins at 8:30 with firing beginning at 10:00. Please arrive early so you can get registered and get your gear together so the first relay can start on time.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS: From I-5 either North or South bound take Exit # 206 172 ST NE (Highway 531 West) Travel approx. 6 miles west (over rail road tracks, past Lakewood High School) to stop sign at intersection of 172NE & 531 West. Turn right travel another 2 miles. Marysville Rifle Club will be on the right.

GOVERNING RULES: Current NRA Police Pistol Combat Rules will govern throughout the Tournaments. All competitors are encouraged to review the current PPC rules. The NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book is available on-line at **ppc.nra.org** or use your smart phone camera to scan the Quick Reader Code, or Double Click on the QR Code. You can also save them to your phone.





RANGE RULES: All competitors will comply with posted Range Rules and directions from the Range Master. For reasons of safety, cross draw, shoulder, and holsters which require the insertion of the finger within the trigger guard will not be allowed.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all law enforcement officers, reserves and Military Police per NRA PPC Rule 2.4. Eligibility Identification, NRA or SFC card must be presented upon request of a Tournament Official.

REGISTRATION: Advanced Registration is not required and can be done at the range on day of the Tournament. Please see the last page for the Registration Form. For further information regarding the Tournament please contact:

MATCHES OFFERED: We will be offering NRA Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol Match 13 and NRA Open Class Revolver Match 6.

Other matches <u>may be offered</u> depending on time limitations such as a Guest Match, Stock Service Semi-Automatic Pistol Match, Stock Service Revolver Match, or Off Duty Gun Match. Match fees and courses of fire will be posted at the range on the day of the Tournament.

TOURNAMENT FEES: First Open Class Revolver or Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol is \$ 20.00. You can fire a second Open Class Match for \$ 15.00.

Match fees cover; NRA Tournament fee of \$4.00 per Open Class Match, \$2.00 goes to the Marysville Rifle Club, WSPPA receives \$2.00 per Open Class Match and \$5.00 of each Open Class Match fee is set aside for range improvements to the PPC Range such as drain fields and turning targets. MRC PPC Shooters will also retain that amount of money needed for Tournament expenses such as targets, frames, and postage. The remaining funds are used for shooter awards.

The entry fees for other matches will be \$5.00 unless the score for that match is being submitted to the NRA, then it will be \$7.00. Of that money \$1.00 will go to WSPPA, \$1.00 will go to the PPC Range Improvement Fund, and \$3.00 will go to the Award Pool for that match. If this is the only match a competitor enters then \$1.00 will go to the WSPPA, \$2.00 will go to pay the MRC Range Use Fee and the remaining \$2.00 will go to the Award Pool for that match.

Classification: Competitors will be entered using their current NRA Police Pistol Combat Classification of High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, Marksman, or Classified. Competitors with expired Classifications, new shooters with no Classification, or those without a Temporary Record Score Book will be registered in the High Master Class as required by PPC Rule 19.2.

Competitors may check their current NRA Classification by using their smart phone camera to scan the Quick Reader Code to the right, by Double Clicking on the QR Code, or by going to **LEcompetitions.nra.org.**

CATEGORIES: PPC shooter categories will not be used in these Tournaments.

CHALLENGES: A challenge fee of \$1.00 will be charged for each Challenge made. NRA Rule 16.1 will govern all Challenges and Rule 16.2 for any Protest.

AWARDS: An award will be made to the Match Winner and to the First in each Classification. Additional awards will be made for each additional 5 competitors in a Classification. If there are less than 5 competitors in a Classification they may be moved up to the next higher class. If there are less than 5 High Masters they will compete for match winner only.

TARGETS: The approved B-27 target will be used. Targets will be scored and changed after the 18 shot 25 yard stage, after the 24 shot 25 yard off hand stage and again after the first two stages of the National Police Course.

SCORING: Scoring will be conducted on line by competitors each time targets are changed. Pursuant to PPC Rule 14.2, **NO** competitor will score their own target **NOR** may a competitor score the targets of a competitor from their same agency. If this cannot be avoided due to the Relay's makeup contact a Match

Official to score the targets. PPC Rules prohibit the use of plug-type gauges. Overlays and Eagle Eyes may be used by competitors. Score cards must be signed and are FINAL once signed so **PLEASE double check** the recorded hits and values **BEFORE signing**.

APPROVED FIREARMS & AMMUNITION: Please see NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book Section 3 for Firearm requirements and the *NRA PPC Rule Book Quick View Firearm Matrix* charts reproduced on the next pages. You can see and print the Rule Book at http://ppc.nra.org/documents/pdf/law/competitions/rulebook.pdf. Competitors should have at least four revolver speedloaders or magazines for their handguns.

PPLIES TO ALL FIREARMS Rule 3.1					
Each competitor is responsible for their firearm and any which may be questionable should be submitted to the Tournament Director, Referee, or 3-Man Jury for decision prior to being used.					
All standard safety features of the pistol must operate properly.					
With respect to Sections 3.2 through 3.10, and in addition to the firearm specific regulations below, the following features are either Allowed or Prohibited on all firearms.					
Action work to make a crisper and/or smoother trigger pull	Allowed				
Fixed or adjustable sights	Allowed				
Sight Blackening	Allowed				
Modification or change of stocks because of the size of a competitor's hand or to facilitate loading	Allowed				
Internal modifications that would render the firearm less safe than originally designed by the manufacturer	Prohibited				
Any external modifications, except those allowed within each rule	Prohibited				
Front sight extending beyond muzzle	Prohibited				
Compensators, barrel venting, or barrel porting	Prohibited				
Ammunition: No high speed or Magnum ammunition will be allowed. Ammunition must be hand loaded or factory loaded to produce sufficient velocity to pass through the target AND the backer. Shots which do not pass through the target and the backer will be scored as misses.

Barrel Length Maximum	6 Inches			
Trigger Pull Minimum: Single Action	2.5 Pounds			
Sight Radius Maximum	8.5 Inches			
Sight Guards which do NOT extend rearward more than 2 inches	Allowed			
External Trigger Stops	Allowed			
Grips/Stocks that when measured from side-to-side at the base are greater than 1 ¾ inches in thickness (1.75')	Prohibited			
Caliber / Ammunition: Either hand loaded or factory loaded ammunition may be used. Wadcutter ammunition is allowed.				

OPEN CLASS SEMI-AUTOMATIC PISTO	OL Rule 3.3			
In addition to the specifications within Section 3.1, the following specifications apply for Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistols.				
Firearm / Caliber: Center-fire pistols of .35 caliber or larger. All double action semi-automatic pistols must fire the first shot of every stage double action except at the 50 yard line.

COURSES OF FIRE:

Time Limits: Time Limits will be announced for each stage or match and start with loaded gun in the holster. No part of the competitor's hand may touch the gun until the command to commence firing is given.

Loading: To force reloading under time restraints and magazines are loaded with a maximum of 6 rounds. There is no limit on the number of magazines or speedloaders you have but after initial loading all ammunition used during the firing of a stage or string MUST be on your person.

Holster: A conventional right or left-handed holster must be used. For safety reasons, shoulder, cross draw or holsters which require releasing by insertion of finger within the trigger guard will not be allowed. Holster cannot be tied down.

Match 1	Match 8	Two stages of 12 shots each fired double action standing without support. First stage fired at 7 yards and second stage fired at 15 yards. Time limit is 20 seconds per stage including time to reload.			
Match 2	Match 9	At 25 yards, 18 rounds fired; 6 shots kneeling; 6 shots standing left handed with support from behind left side of barricade, 6 shots standing right handed with support from behind right side of barricade, all fired double action. Time limit 90 seconds, including time to reload. Change Target			
Match 3	Match 10	At 50 yards, 24 rounds fired; 6 shots sitting; 6 shots prone; 6 shots standing left handed with support from behind left side of barricade; 6 shots standing right handed with support from behind right side of barricade. All shots may be fired single or double action. Time limit 2 minutes and 45 seconds including time to reload.			
Match 4	Match 11	At 25 yards, 24 rounds fired in two stages of 12 shots each fired double action, standing without support. Time limit 35 seconds for each 12-shot stage including time to reload. Change Target			
Match 5	Match 12	 Stage 1: 7 yards, 12 shots double action standing without support. Time limit 20 seconds including time to reload. Stage 2: 25 yards, 6 shots kneeling; 6 shots standing left handed with support from behind left side of barricade, and 6 shots standing right handed with support from behind right side of barricade. All fired double action. Time limit 90 seconds, including time to reload. Stage 3: 50 yards, 6 shots sitting; 6 shots prone; 6 shots standing left handed with support from behind left side of barricade and 6 shots standing right handed with support from behind right side of barricade. All shots may be fired single or double action. Time limit 2 minutes and 45 seconds including time to reload. Stage 4: 25 yards, 6 shots double action standing without support. Time limit 12 seconds. 			
Match 6	Match 13	Match 6 is the Aggregate score of the Open Class Revolver shooters Match 1 through Match 5 with a total possible score of 1500 points. Match 13 is the Aggregate score of the Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol shooters Match 8 through 12 with a total possible score of 1500 points.
