ELIGIBILITY: Open to all law enforcement officers, reserves and Military Police per NRA PPC Rules 2.4 through 2.6. There will be no team matches. Identification to support Law Enforcement or Military Police status must be available and shown on demand of Match officials.

REGISTRATION: The Registration Form is on the last page of this program. While advanced registration is not required it is highly recommended. If not pre-registered please report at least 45 minutes prior to the match to register and bring your completed Registration Form with you. To pre-register complete the Registration Form and mail it in following the instructions of the form.

RULES: Current NRA Police Pistol Combat Rules will govern throughout the Tournaments. All competitors are encouraged to review the current PPC rules. The NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book is available on-line at ppc.nra.org or use your smart phone camera to scan the Quick Reader Code, or Double Click on the QR Code. You can also save them to your phone.



RANGE RULES: All competitors will comply with posted range rules and directions from Match Officials.

RELAY TIMES: Additional NRA Open Class Match, NRA Duty and Off Duty Gun Matches and LCPCPC Combat 600 Matches will be scheduled as needed dependent on attendance but participants must be registered by 12:00 noon for these extra matches.

- Relay 1 - 8:15 am: LCPCPC Combat 600 Stock & LCPCPA Open Gun Match
- Relay 2 - 8:45 am: LCPCPC Combat 600 Stock & LCPCPC Open Gun Match
- Relay 3 - 9:20 am: LCPCPC Combat 600 Handicapped Match

- Relay 4 - 9:35 am: LCPCPC Combat 600 Handicapped Match
- Relay 5 - 9:50 am: LCPCPC Combat 600 Stock & LCPCPC Open Gun Match
- Relay 6 - 10:30 am: NRA Open Class Division Matches – Fire either Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol Matches 8-12 or NRA Open Class Revolver Matches 1 -5.
- Relay 7 - 12:00 pm: NRA Duty Gun Division Match – Fire either Stock Service Semi-Automatic Pistol Match 14, Stock Service Revolver Match 7, Off Duty Semi-Automatic Pistol Match 15A, or Off Duty Revolver Match 15R.
- Relay 8 - 12:30 pm: LCPCPC Combat 600 Stock & LCPCPC Open Gun Match

TOURNAMENT FEES:

- LCPCPC Combat 600 = \$ 10.00 for the first and \$5.00 for additional relays
- NRA Duty Gun Division Match, Per Relay = \$ 7.00
- NRA Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol Match 8 thru 12 or Open Class Revolver Matches 1 thru 5 = \$ 25.00
- NRA Open Class Division Re-fire with same handgun (*scores cannot be submitted to NRA*) = \$ 10.00
- NRA Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol or Open Class Revolver Match and LCPCPC Combat 600 Match = \$ 30.00
- NRA Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol, Open Class Revolver Match and LCPCPC Combat 600 Match = \$ 45.00

PPC CLASSIFICATION: Competitors will be entered using their current NRA Police Pistol Combat Classification of High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, Marksman, or Classified. Competitors with expired Classifications, new shooters with no Classification, or those without a Temporary Record Score Book will be registered in the High Master Class as required by PPC Rule 19.2.

Competitors may check their current NRA Classification by using their smart phone camera to scan this Quick Reader Code, by Double Clicking on the QR Code, or by going to <https://lecompetitions.nra.org/police-pistol-combat/shooter-classification-lookup/>.



CATEGORIES: PPC shooter categories will not be used in these Tournaments.

CHALLENGES: A challenge fee of \$1.00 will be charged for each Challenge made. NRA Rule 16.1 will govern all Challenges and Rule 16.2 for any Protest.

AWARDS: Cash, Medals and T-Shirts. Number and assignment will depend on competitor numbers

TARGETS: The approved NRA B-27 Target will be used.

SCORING: Scoring will be conducted on line by competitors each time targets are changed. Pursuant to PPC Rule 14.2, **NO competitor** will score their own target **NOR may a competitor** score the targets of a competitor from their same agency. If this cannot be avoided due to the Relay’s makeup contact a Match Official to score the targets. PPC Rules prohibit the use of plug-type scoring gauges. Overlays and Eagle Eyes may be used by competitors. Score cards must be signed and are FINAL once signed so **PLEASE double check the recorded hits and values BEFORE signing.**

COURSES OF FIRE:

Time Limits: Time Limits will be announced for each stage or match and start with loaded gun in the holster. No part of the competitor's hand may touch the gun until the command to commence firing is given.

Loading: To force reloading under time restraints and magazines are loaded with a maximum of 6 rounds. There is no limit on the number of magazines or speedloaders you have but after initial loading all ammunition used during the firing of a stage or string **MUST** be on your person.

Holster: A conventional right or left-handed holster must be used. For safety reasons, shoulder, cross draw or holsters which require releasing by insertion of finger within the trigger guard will not be allowed. Holster cannot be tied down.
