Governing Rules: Current NRA Police Pistol Combat Rules will govern throughout the Tournaments. All competitors are encouraged to review the current PPC rules. The NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book is available on-line at ppc.nra.org or use your smart phone camera to scan the Quick Reader Code, or Double Click on the QR Code. You can also save them to your phone.



Eligibility: Open to any eligible law enforcement member as outlined in Police Pistol Combat Rule Section 2.

This Tournament is also open to any civilian <u>sponsored</u> by a current member of the NMPPCA. Civilian scores will not be forwarded to NRA Law Enforcement Competitions for Classification purposes.

Individuals may join the NRA and the New Mexico Police Pistol Combat Association (NMPPCA) during Tournament registration.

Range Safety: The range safety rules are posted at the entrance to the range and will be followed by all competitors and observers. Failure to comply may result in Disqualification with no refund of Tournament Fees.

Shooting Times: The first relay will commence firing at 0900 hours with additional Matches and Relays following until such time as all scheduled events are concluded. Most NMPPCA Tournaments are finished by 1400 hours.

Registration: Registration will be on site and begin at 0830 hours. Registration for events will be accepted up to the starting time of the event.

Release of Liability: Each competitor will be required to read and consent to a NMPPCA Liability Disclaimer prior to participating in any NMPPCA sanctioned event.

Fees: Please refer to the fee schedule available at Registration or call ahead of time.

Matches Offered and Firing Order:

Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol match 8 thru 12 & Open Class Revolver Matches 1 thru 5 = 2 Relays Stock Service Semi-Automatic Pistol Match 14 & Stock Service Revolver Match 7 = 2 Relays Production Pistol Match 23 = 1 Relay

Off Duty Semi-Automatic Pistol and Off Duty Revolver Matches 15 = 1 Relay

Ammunition: Please see Police Pistol Combat Rule 3.17 for allowable ammunition and the Firearms Allowed Section at the end of this program.

Squadding: There will be no assigned squadding, however the NMPPCA relies on the integrity of its member-competitors and therefore, operates all Tournaments on the honor system. It will be the policy of the NMPPCA to pair an experienced competitor next to a first time or in-experienced competitor for reinforcement of rules and procedures.

Classification: Competitors will be entered using their current NRA Police Pistol Combat Classification of High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, Marksman, or Classified. Competitors with expired Classifications, new shooters with no Classification, or those without a Temporary Record Score Book will be registered in the High Master Class as required by PPC Rule 19.2.

Competitors may check their current NRA Classification by using their smart phone camera to scan this Quick Reader Code, by Double Clicking on the QR Code, or by going to https://lecompetitions.nra.org/police-pistol-combat/shooter-classification-lookup/.



Categories: There will be no categories used in these Tournaments.

Awards: The NMPPCA will distribute awards/prizes to the top competitors based on availability and budgetary constraints. However, the top competitor of each Tournament will be refunded the cost of competition for that Tournament only. The top competitor must have fired each match to be considered for this award.

Targets: Official NRA B-27 targets will be used.

Scoring: Competitor scoring will be used using face value scoring of Hits in the X, 10, 9, 8, and 7 scoring rings. Pursuant to PPC Rule 14.2, **NO** competitor will score their own target **NOR** may a competitor score the targets of a competitor from their same agency. If this cannot be avoided due to the Relay's makeup contact a Match Official to score the targets. PPC Rules prohibit the use of plug-type scoring gauges. Overlays and Eagle Eyes may be used by competitors. Score cards must be signed and are FINAL once signed so **PLEASE** double check the recorded hits and values BEFORE signing.

Courses of Fire: The Range Officer will announce the course of fire, shooting positions and time limits prior to the start of each Match and Stage. Time will start with a loaded gun in holster. No part of the competitor's hand may touch the gun or holster until the command to commence firing is given. All loading will be with cartridges taken from the competitor's pocket, cartridge belt, mechanical loaders, or special pouch. To force reloading under time restraints, magazine loading is limited to 6

rounds per magazine. There is no limit on the number of magazines you may have but all used during the firing of a stage or string MUST be on your person. It is the competitors' responsibility to have sufficient ammunition in their possession to complete the Match being fired.

A conventional right or left-hand holster must be used. For safety reasons, shoulder, cross draw or holsters which require releasing by insertion of finger within the trigger guard will not be allowed. Holster cannot be tied down.

Optical Devices: No optical devices other than normal glasses worn for corrective eyesight or Sunglasses will be permitted on the range during Match firing for use by competitors. Use of a mechanical iris, eye patch or eye cover is also prohibited.

Firearm / Caliber: Approved Pistols for this Division are listed in Police Pistol Combat Bulletin 14.1 on the Law Enforcement Competitions website. To be considered for approval the pistol must be a mass produced center-fire semi-automatic pistol made for police or military use (at least 1,000 pistols), a stock catalog item that is unmodified from its original factory condition, and have a double, double/single, or striker type action. Double/single actions pistols must have a manual decocking device, or equipped with an automatic decocker that returns the pistol to double action mode when the slide is released. All double/single action and double action pistols must fire the first shot of every stage double action.
