Eligibility: Open to any eligible law enforcement member as outlined in Police Pistol Combat Rule Section 2.4. Identification to support Law Enforcement or Military Police status must be available and shown on demand of a Tournament Official.

Classification: Competitors will be entered using their current NRA Police Pistol Combat Classification of High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, Marksman, or Classified. Competitors with expired Classifications, new shooters with no Classification, or those without a Temporary Record Score Book will be registered in the High Master Class as required by PPC Rule 19.2.

Competitors may check their current NRA Classification at **LEcompetitions.nra.org** or by using their smart phone camera to scan this Quick Reader Code, by Double Clicking on the QR Code with your cursor.

Categories: There will be no categories used in the monthly Registered Tournaments. The Categories found in PPC Rule 2.6 may be used at the Dixie National's Regional Tournament and Alabama State Championship Tournament.

Tournament Fees: Include NRA Match Fees

Alabama Governor's Twenty Monthly Registered PPC Tournaments:

Awards: The Number and Assignment of Awards will depend on competitor numbers and will consist of;

- Cash
- Trophies/Medals
- Certificates
- Door Prizes

Final Result Bulletins: Will be posted and sent to competitors if requested.

Registration: For Onsite Registration please complete the appropriate Competitor Registration Form at the end and bring it with you to the range at least 45 minutes prior to the first match. Ranges open at 8:00 am and the first relay will begin at 9:00 am.

For Pre-Registration please complete either the Alabama Governor's Twenty Monthly Registered Tournament Competitor Registration Form, the Dixie National's Regional Tournament Registration Form,

or the Alabama State Championship Tournament Competitor Registration Form and follow the instructions on the form for submission.

Range Rules: All competitors will comply with posted range rules and directions from Tournament Officials.

Targets: Official NRA B-27 targets will be used.

Scoring: Competitor scoring will be used. Pursuant to PPC Rule 14.2, **NO** competitor will score their own target **NOR** may a competitor score the targets of a competitor from their same agency. If this cannot be avoided due to the Relay's makeup contact a Tournament Official to score the targets. PPC Rules prohibit the use of plug-type scoring gauges. Overlays and Eagle Eyes may be used by competitors.

Score cards must be signed and are FINAL once signed so **PLEASE** double check the recorded hits and values BEFORE signing.

Challenges: See PPC Rule 16.1 for procedures with a Challenge Fee of \$5.00 for each Challenge made.

Match Times and Relays: Ranges open at 8:00 am. The first match will begin at 9:00 am with the rest of the matches beginning at the conclusion of the prior match. The normal match order will be;

- Stock Service Revolver Match 7
- Open Class Division Matches Fire either Open Class Revolver Matches 1 through 5 or Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol Matches 8 through 12.
- Stock Service Semi-Automatic Pistol Match 14
- Dixie National's Regional and Alabama State Championship Tournament: Distinguished Revolver Match 17, Distinguished Semi-Automatic Pistol Match 18, Distinguished Production Match 24, and Two Officer Team Matches will be added with the Match Order posted at a later date.

Courses of Fire: The Range Tower will announce the course of fire, shooting positions and time prior to the start of each Match and Stage. Time will start with a loaded gun in holster. No part of the competitor's hand may touch the gun or holster until the command to commence firing is given.

All loading will be with cartridges taken from the competitor's pocket, cartridge belt, mechanical loaders, or special pouch. To force reloading under time restraints, magazine loading is limited to 6 rounds per magazine. There is no limit on the number of magazines you have but all used during at the firing of a stage or string MUST be on your person.

A conventional right or left-hand holster must be used. For safety reasons, shoulder, cross draw or holsters which require releasing by insertion of finger within the trigger guard will not be allowed. Holster cannot be tied down.

Firearm / Caliber: Approved Pistols for this Division are listed in Police Pistol Combat Bulletin 14.1 on the Law Enforcement Competitions website. To be considered, must be a mass produced center-fire semi-automatic pistol made for police or military use (at least 1,000 pistols), unmodified stock catalog item in its original factory condition, and have a double, double/single, or striker type action. Must be capable of chambering and firing .35 caliber or larger ammunition, or FN 5.7 x 28 caliber ammunition. All double action semi-automatic pistols must fire the first shot of every stage double action.

When you get your Production Distinguished scorecard YOU must record your competitor information, the information about the Production Pistol and Sights you want to use, the page number your pistol is listed on and its Aproval Number in

NRA Police Pistol Combat Bulletin 14-1.

Prior to shooting, your pistol MUST be INSPECTED and TRIGGER PULL WEIGHED to Certify your pistol as approved by a Tournament Official who will sign your scorecard.

Scorecards are later reviewed by NRA LE
Competitions before your score is validated
and recorded. Scorecards with missing
information or not signd by a Tournament
Official are not recorded so YOU need to make
sure all sections on the scorecard are complete.

Please note that YOU must record your sight information on your NRA Production Distinguished Pistol Scorecard.

So if you have replaced the original sights make sure you know the name, model of the sight, the page number they are listed on, and their Approval Number as listed in

Police Pistol Combat Bulletin 16-1.

The NRA has made it clear that NO matter what APPROVED Replacement Sight is used, the sights MUST keep a <u>Duty Gun</u> Point of Aim/Point of Impact, NOT a competition set up, such as a Neck Hold, Shoulder Hold, or Head Hold.

A Duty Gun Point of Aim/Point of Impact sight set up requires the sights to be aligned on the X Ring/Center Mass to obtain a Hit in the X Ring/Center Mass area.

Pistols with competition sight set ups will be Disqualified, even if having already been used to fire a Match. Competitors may be required to allow their pistol to be test fired, or checked with a laser boresighter to check

the sight set up.
