These Tournaments are a great way for you to evaluate your skill level, identify needed training areas, improve your qualification scores, and practice your handgun skills to keep you prepared for the ever-increasing dangers you face on the street, off duty, or as a retired officer.

You do NOT need any fancy gear or guns to start shooting and see how challenging and fun these matches are. Just bring your duty handgun, four magazines, holster & magazine pouch. There is nothing to memorize, the course will be announced as you shoot just like the stages during a qualification and fellow officers will gladly help you out.

National Police Course will be fired for the Open Class Matches.

Directions: From the Long Island Expressway - Long Island Expressway (495) eastbound to exit 71. At the end of the exit ramp make a left and go under the expressway. Go past the gas station on the left to the first left turn (Mill Rd.). Proceed about ¼ mile and look to your left. Two white posts on either side of the entrance mark the entrance to the range. Take the entrance road to the parking area and range house. No vehicles are permitted on the range itself.

Governing Rules: Current NRA Police Pistol Combat Rules will govern throughout the Tournament. All competitors are encouraged to review the current PPC rules. The NRA Police Pistol Combat Rule Book is available on-line at **ppc.nra.org** or use your smart phone camera to scan the Quick Reader Code or place your cursor on it and press CTRL and CLICK.



Eligibility: Open to any eligible law enforcement member as outlined in Police Pistol Combat Rule Section 2.4. These include active and retired Law Enforcement Officers, and <u>full time</u> Police Firearms

Instructors, Transit Police, Penal Institution Guards, Industrial Police which includes Bank Guards and Armored and Express Company Guards, and Military Police. Federal Flight Deck Officers who hold valid certifications are also eligible.

NRA Membership is not required for any NRA competitions but is encouraged. A special law enforcement discount form for NRA Membership and Renewal will be available at check in.

Classification: Competitors will be entered using their current NRA Police Pistol Combat Classification of High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, Marksman, or Classified. Competitors with expired Classifications and **new shooters** with no Classification or those without a Temporary Record Score Book **must** fire in the High Master Class as required by PPC Rule 19.2.

You can check your current NRA Classification at **LEcompetitions.nra.org** or by using your smart phone camera to scan the Quick Reader Code to the right or place your computer cursor on it and or place your cursor on it and press CTRL and CLICK.



Categories: There will be no categories used in these Tournaments.

Squadding: The Open Class Division Matches will be squadded. Competitors are requested to pick up their squadding packet from the Statistical Office at least one half hour prior to scheduled match time. NRA Police Combat Pistol Classification cards, New York Police Combat Association Governor 20 cards and department ID must be presented.

Awards: A competitor will not be awarded multiple awards. For instance an Aggregate Award and a Class Award. The Award Priority will be Aggregate, Class and then Match. After winning their first Award, any additional Awards will be reassigned to the next highest scoring competitor in the Class or Match.

• NRA Open Class Division: Competitor's First Open Class Division Match scores will be used, whether they fired an Open Class Revolver or an Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol Match.

First Place Overall = Cash Award

Class Awards = Cash for First Place in Class if there are 10 competitors in the Class.

Individual Matches: As with the Open Class Division Aggregate, similar Open Class Matches will be combined for Award purposes. For Instance, First Match scores for Open Class Revolver Match 1 shooters will be combined with the First Match Open Class Semi-Automatic Pistol Match 8 shooter scores. The Combined Matches are: Matches 1 & 8, Matches 2 & 9, Matches 3 & 10, Matches 4 & 11 and Matches 5 & 12.

There will be a First Place Cash Award when there are 10 to 14 competitors in the Match. A Second

Place Cash Award will be added if there are 15 to 19 competitors in the Match and a Third Place Cash Award will be added when there are 20 or more competitors in the Match.

- NYPCA Service Weapon Match Stock Service Revolver: Cash Awards based on the Lewis System.
- NYPCA Service Weapon Match Stock Service Semi-Automatic Pistol: Cash Awards based on the Lewis System.
- NYPCA Semi-Automatic Pistol Match: Cash Awards based on the Lewis System.

Match & Relay Schedule: Please ensure you arrive early enough to complete your Registration Check-In and get your gear and firearms ready. Scheduled Relays are limited to 7 competitors. If there are more shooters additional Relays will be added after all existing Relays are filled.

Registration: The range is limited to 7 competitors per Relay. Competitors that Pre-Register with a deposit are guaranteed a spot. All others will be wait-listed. Please see the last page for the Registration Form. All competitors need to bring a completed Registration Form with them to the Tournament to speed the Check-In process. All competitors MUST present the following items during Registration:

- 1. Valid Department or Agency Identification
- 2. Current Classification Card or current Temporary Classification Book unless they have not fired in a PPC Tournament before.

Alibis: NONE! Only exception are Range Officer alibis.

Refires: See NRA PPC Rule Section 9.

Targets: Official NRA B-27 Targets and Repair Centers will be used.

Scoring: Competitor scoring will be used. Pursuant to PPC Rule 14.2, **NO** competitor will score their own target **NOR** may a competitor score the targets of a competitor from their same agency. If this cannot be avoided due to the Relay's makeup contact a Match Official to score the targets. PPC Rules prohibit the use of plug-type scoring gauges. Overlays and Eagle Eyes may be used by competitors. Score cards must be signed and are FINAL once signed so **PLEASE** double check the recorded hits and values BEFORE signing.

Challenges: Target scoring Challenges will follow PPC Rule 16.1 with a Challenge Fee of \$3.00 which will be returned to the competitor if the Challenge is upheld. The three-person jury will decide Challenges.

Result Bulletins: Final Result Bulletins will be provided.

Courses of Fire & Equipment: The Range Officer will announce the course of fire, shooting positions and time limits prior to the start of each Match and Stage. Time will start with a loaded gun in holster. No part of the competitor's hand may touch the gun or holster until the command to commence firing is given.

Holsters: A conventional right or left-hand holster must be used. For safety reasons, shoulder, cross draw, IWB, or holsters which require releasing by insertion of finger within the trigger guard will not be allowed. Holsters cannot be tied down.

Firing Method: Matches or States designated as Double Action must be fired Double Action. Matches or Stages designated Single action may be fired either Single action or Double Action. All Double Action semi-automatic pistols must fire the first shot of every Stage double Action except at the 50 yard line.

Loading: All loading will be with cartridges taken from the competitor's pocket, cartridge belt, mechanical loaders, or special pouch. To force reloading under time constraints, magazine loading is limited to 6 rounds per magazine. There is no limit on the number of magazines you may have but all used during the firing of a stage or string MUST be on your person. It is the competitors' responsibility to have sufficient ammunition in their possession to complete the Match being fired.

Optical Devices: No optical devices other than normal glasses worn for corrective eyesight or Sunglasses will be permitted on the range during Match firing for use by competitors. Use of a mechanical iris, eye patch or eye cover is also prohibited.

If a competitor is uncertain about any equipment being eligible, they must contact the Tournament Director or NRA Match Supervisor for a decision prior to firing the first Match.

Ear & Eye Protection Must Be Worn By Competitors & Spectators During All Matches. Please Exercise Normal Precautions For Ticks.

The 60 round NRA National Police Course will be fired for the Open Class Matches.

APPLIES TO ALL FIREARMS Rule 3.1 Each competitor is responsible for their firearm and any which may be questionable should be submitted to the Tournament Director, Referee, or 3-Man Jury for decision prior to being used.
